Class 1. Best Junior Handler

11.00am

We will be looking for the young handler and dog that interact well with each other.

Class 2. Best Rescue Dog

11.30am

Open to any breed/mixed breed. Judges will be looking for the best rescue story and details of the special bond the owner has with their dog.

Class 3. Most Fabulous Fella - Best Male Dog

12.00noon

Open to any breed/mixed breed. Judges will be looking for male dogs over the age of one year who look healthy and happy. They will also be looking at the dogs' character and the special bond the owner has with their dog.

Class 4. Golden Oldie - Best Dog Over 10 Years

12.30pm

Open to any breed/mixed breed. Judges will be looking for dogs (male or female) over the age of 10 years, who look healthy and happy for their age

Class 5. Best Hair Do

1.00pm

Open to any breed/mixed breed. Judges will be looking for gorgeous dogs (male or female) with healthy-looking coats, whether they've been groomed to perfection or look like they've just rolled out of bed!

Class 6. Judge's favourite 15kg and Over

1.30pm

Open to all dogs weighing 15kg or over, which one will woo the judge and be the one they most want to take home with them?

Class 7. Best Paw Shaker

2.00pm

Open to any breed/mixed breed. Judges will be looking for dogs (male or female) who are happy to give their paw to them for a shake. The owner is permitted to give a command or treat if needed

Class 8. Dog with the Waggiest Tail

2.30pm

Open to any breed/mixed breed dog, male or female, with a happy nature. The judges will count the number of wags in 30 seconds.

Class 10. Most Fantastic Family - 3 Or More Dogs **11.30pm**

Open to any breeds/mixed breeds. Judges will be looking for a family of three or more dogs who enjoy a special bond between them and their humans.

Class 11. Loveliest Lady - Best Female Dog **12.00noon**

Open to any breed/mixed breed. Judges will be looking for female dogs who look healthy and happy. They will also be looking at the dogs' character and the special bond the owner has with their dog.

Class 12. Best Puppy **12.30pm**

Open to any breed/mixed breed. Judges will be looking for puppies who look healthy and happy, including with healthy coats, bright eyes and of a good weight. They will also be looking at the pups' character and the special bond the owner has with their puppy.

Class 13. Judge's favourite under 15kg **1.30pm**

Open to all dogs, which one will woo the judge and be the one they most want to take home?

Class 14. Friendliest Dog **3.00pm**

Open to any breed/mixed breed. Judges will be looking for dogs (male or female) which they believe to be the friendliest dog in the class.

SHOW CHAMPIONSHIP **3.45pm**

All dogs winning first or second in classes 1 – 14 are eligible to compete in the championship. Special prizes to be awarded to the champion and reserve champion. No entry fee required.
