Lunches

A splendid cold buffet lunch is available to book for show day at £25 per lunch. Pre-booking is advisable as a limited number will be available on show day at £30 per lunch

* DOGS— Only permitted in the designated area in the outdoor members' enclosure. Dogs must be on a short lead and MUST NOT, at any time, enter the members' marquee, except for guide/assistance dogs.

* Children under 16 yrs have free admission to the Show, however a Junior membership must be purchased for access to the members' enclosure.

* Membership for children aged under 4 is free and no badge is required to gain access to the members' enclosure.

* The Show will make no refund of membership subscriptions in the event of the Show being cancelled for whatever reason.

* The Show has the right to refuse any membership application.

* Membership of the Hanbury Countryside Show does not provide a voting entitlement.

Direct Debit

Sally will send you a link to complete the Direct Debit mandate online. You will then receive email confirmations from Go Cardless.

Please note –subscriptions due by Direct Debit are due on the 1st January each year, and cover membership in advance for that year.

Therefore if you wish to set up a Direct Debit after the 1st January, you will need to arrange alternative payment for the current year.
