Subject: Reaffirmation of Our Community's Spiritual Standing

To Whom It May Concern

We write to you on behalf of The Community Assembly of the British Isles - a fully established spiritual community that has existed and operated independently with its own framework of beliefs, principles, and spiritual practices for many years.

Our belief system, while peaceful and respectful of the broader society, exists parallel to and outside of the formal structures and expectations of your UK Government system (sometimes referred to as the Westminster Parliament). As such, we request that our status be acknowledged and respected in all dealings with local or national establishments. We also have our own Community Peace Service with Peace Keepers and Constables in uniform providing a service to our members under Natural Law supported by our own courts known to us as Kort Ownder. There are many other aspects to our communities including health, education, food supply and shelter, all of which align with our beliefs.

Our spiritual path is not aligned with conventional political, legal, or religious affiliations recognized by the state, and our internal governance reflects our unique understanding of community, service, and spiritual law. We function in unity and mutual respect, maintaining a peaceful existence that does not interfere with the wider public but rather seeks to live in harmony with all.

We trust that, as enshrined in the principles of freedom of belief and conscience, our right to operate as an independent spiritual body is respected. We kindly reiterate our request that our position be formally recognised in your records and that future interactions take into consideration our standing as a self-contained, spiritually independent community and that in accordance with our free vote on the 2nd March 2024 all Facilitators and Emissaries of the Assemblies of the World be afforded diplomatic status.

We welcome respectful communication and are always open to dialogue that honours mutual understanding, goodwill and honesty.
