WHAT IS NATURAL LAW?

WHAT IS HIDDEN KNOWLEDGE?

There are two aspects of universal knowledge that have been hidden from us.

Macro Knowledge – universal spiritual law

Micro Knowledge – our existence as creative beings of spiritual consciousness

This is to create a power differential between the 'few who know' and 'we the people'.

WHAT IS HIDDEN KNOWLEDGE?

Universal Spiritual Law governs the consequences of behaviour for intelligent species.

Human beings are able to gain understanding through knowledge.

Sentient (animal) beings do not share the same level of consciousness.

This means 'we' are the ones to be held accountable for the choices we make through our own free will.

Natural Law has nothing to do with:

- **religion**
- **theories of evolution**
- **the law of the jungle**
- **the so-called natural order of 'dog eat dog'**
- **anything that is manmade**

WHAT IS NATURAL LAW?

The existing condition of the laws of Nature are binding and immutable.

Knowledge about natural laws cannot be readily seen or measured.

Natural Law can be understood by the observable effects of 'cause and effect'.

Understanding Natural Law therefore constitutes a science of morality.

WHAT IS NATURAL LAW?

WHAT IS NATURAL LAW?

Living according to Natural Law requires:

- **Knowing the difference between right and wrong**
- **Understanding the effect of our behaviour on others**
- **Never intentionally causing harm to ourselves or any sentient being**
- **Being responsible by using our 'free will' to do the right thing**

This is critical for us to be able to live in peace, harmony and freedom together.

WHAT IS NATURAL LAW?

WHAT IS FREE WILL?

Natural Law governs the aggregate or collective.

Free will represents our behavioural choices.

Human beings manifest the consequences of chosen behaviours.

The consequences we receive are always dependent on moral or immoral behaviours.

We all have free will but we are not insulated from the consequences of our moral choices.

WHAT IS NATURAL LAW?

WHAT IS OBJECTIVE MORALITY?

Morality is NOT based on:

- **perceptions**
- **opinions**
- **feelings**
- **beliefs**
- **doctrines or ideologies**
- **the whims of those who seek to control us**

WHAT IS NATURAL LAW?

WHAT IS OBJECTIVE MORALITY?

A behaviour is either right or wrong.

It causes harm to another or it does not.

To behave with right action is moral, to behave with wrong action is immoral.

It is currently grossly misunderstood that no-one gets to decide what is moral or immoral.

This fundamental premise of Natural Law pre-exists and is inherent in the creative world itself.

WHAT IS NATURAL LAW?

WHAT ARE HUMAN RIGHTS?

A 'right' is an action that does not cause harm to another sentient being (human and animal).

There are four main tenets of Natural Law:

- **Do no harm**
- **Commit no fraud**
- **Cause no loss**
- **Keep the peace**

All our members agree to abide by the four tenets of Natural Law.

BY AGREEING TO ABIDE BY NATURAL LAW, WE
COLLECTIVELY CHOOSE TO TAKE RESPONSIBILITY
FOR OUR ACTIONS AND TO LIVE PEACEABLY AND
COOPERATIVELY WITH EACH OTHER.

WHAT IS NATURAL LAW?

CHOOSING FREEDOM

Every non-voluntary manmade 'law' is in opposition to Natural Law.

Not understanding this one essential point has led us into slavery.
