- **Hard Work**: Success in cheerleading comes through consistent effort and dedication. We believe that hard work pays off, whether in practice, competition, or everyday life. Our athletes are taught the value of perseverance and commitment to achieving their goals.
- **Accountability**: Being accountable means taking responsibility for one's actions and choices. We hold our athletes to high standards, encouraging them to be responsible for their training, behavior, and growth. Accountability also extends to being dependable teammates and following through on commitments.

We ask that as parents, you support and reinforce these values at home, creating a consistent, positive environment for your athlete's growth and success.

We want to remind everyone that we have an open-door policy, which means we encourage open communication and transparency. If you have any concerns, questions, or issues, please don't hesitate to bring them to us immediately. Your feedback is important, and we are here to support you. Our goal is to foster a positive and productive environment where everyone feels heard and valued.

Tuition

The monthly tuition for **competition cheer is \$145**, and it is auto drafted on the 1st of each month. If payment is declined a **\$25 late fee** will be added to your payment.

The monthly tuition for competition **Tiny Cheer is \$110**, and it is drafted on the 1st of each month. If payment is declined a **\$25 late fee** will be added to your payment.

All Other Fees: These fees will be drafted from your Iclass account on the due date. If payment is declined a \$50 late fee will be applied.

Return check fees:

\$25 for the first returned check

\$50 for the second returned check

\$100 for the third returned check. After the third you must update your method of payment.

All payments will be **AUTOMATICALLY DRAFTED** through your IclassPro account, and it's **required** that you have a valid payment method on file at all times. Your account must be in good standing **two weeks** prior to any competition. Failure to meet this requirement will result in your athlete being benched from the upcoming competition routine. **No refunds will be given under any circumstances.**

Please be aware that if your athlete quits for any reason or is removed from the program for any reason, there will be **no refunds** provided and payments are non transferable. You are **committed to a full May-May season** and are responsible for all charges and fees associated with the entire season for your athlete. If you or your athlete choose to withdraw midseason, for any reason, a \$250 re-choreography fee will be automatically deducted from the card on the account on file, **NO EXCEPTIONS.**

Attendance Fees:

1st offense \$10

2nd offense \$25

3rd offense \$250 and dismissal from the team will be automatically charged to your payment method on file via your Iclass account for tardiness, unexcused absences, or leaving early from practice.

Additionally a \$25 fee will be automatically charged to your payment method on file via your iclass account for being late to arrival time at comp! It is VERY important that everyone arrives on time and ready to go!

Important Notes:

- ***Tuition is not waived or prorated for reasons such as illness, vacation, injury, or voluntary time off.***
- ***Participation in Florida Elite Sharks programs constitutes agreement to all policies outlined in this packet.***
- ***You are making a commitment, and we expect that commitment to be honored throughout the season.***
- ***Prices are subject to change at any time.***
- ***No private lessons or other purchases within the gym may be made if your Iclass account is in a past due status.***
- ***No refunds. No exceptions.***
- ***Applying a stop payment from your bank is considered a breach of contract and further legal action will take place!***
- ***You do not have to pay your tuition in full, however if you do, no refunds will be given. NO EXCEPTIONS!***
- ***Florida Elite Sharks reserves the right to dismiss any athlete from the program at any time for reasonable cause, including but not limited to behavior issues, repeated policy violations, bullying, disrespect, attendance concerns, or actions that negatively impact the team environment. Our goal is to maintain a positive, safe, and respectful atmosphere for all athletes and families.***

FES Athletics reserves the right to adjust any fee in this packet or to add fees for unforeseen circumstances. A sufficient notice will be given in this circumstance. No reimbursement or prorations will be provided for reasons such as illness, vacation, injury, or voluntary time off. Once you sign this document and commit to the season, you are obligated to pay all fees listed above (no exceptions).

Flyers- All flyers must arrive 30 mins before their scheduled practice time to work flexibility, motions, etc.

If your athlete misses a scheduled flyer stretch session for any reason, that practice must be made up with a private lesson.

All make-up lessons must be:

- Scheduled through iClass
- Paid for separately (private lessons are not included in tuition)

Crossovers- A crossover is an athlete that competes on more than one team. This athlete must attend all practices for both the teams they are committed to, as well as extra practices. This is a BIG commitment and a BIG reward at the same time. Being a crossover is completely optional. If you select that your athlete is interested in crossing over teams, they still may not be needed or chosen to do so. The coaches and gym owner will be the one to choose what team(s) they are placed on and the different positions/roles they may play on the team(s). Crossovers do pay extra tuition, competition fees, uniforms, bows, practice wear, etc. Crossovers can expect to pay approximately 8 payments of \$450.

Attendance Policy

Attendance is Critical to Success: Cheerleading is a team sport, and your athlete's presence at practice is essential for the success of the entire team. When one athlete is absent, it costs your stunt group, timing, tumbling progression, and full routine momentum. To ensure we perform at our best, all practices, stunt camps, choreo camps, and competitions are mandatory—NO EXCUSES!

In addition, please know that our coaches put in significant time each week to prepare a structured practice plan in advance. This planning is essential to ensuring a smooth and effective practice. Last-minute absences can disrupt the flow of practice and make it challenging to execute the plan as intended. We appreciate your commitment to consistent attendance, which helps maintain productive and well-organized training sessions for the entire team.

If your athlete misses a scheduled practice for any reason, that practice must be made up with a private lesson.

All make-up lessons must be:

- Scheduled through iClass
- Paid for separately (private lessons are not included in tuition)

This policy helps ensure athletes stay on track with skills, safety, and team progress.

Notifying Us of Absences:

- If your athlete is sick or unable to attend practice, text the gym at **386-222-2877** with at least 24 hours' notice.
- If notice is given within 1 hour of practice or not at all, it will be considered a **non-excused** absence and ***will incur an automatic \$25 charge drafted from the payment method on file in your I-Class Pro account*** for the first offense.
- A doctor's note is required for any absences and must be **emailed** prior to returning to practice. If a doctor's note is not obtained your athlete should be at practice.
- Sick or injury related excuses with no doctor's note ***will incur an automatic \$25 charge drafted from the payment method on file in your I-Class Pro account.***

Unexcused Absences:

- 3 unexcused absences will result in automatic dismissal from the team. **NO EXCEPTIONS! NO REFUNDS!**

On-Time and Ready:

- Athletes must show up on time and be fully prepared for practice. **Every Practice – Required Items:**
 - Cheer shoes
 - No jewelry
 - Hair in a high ponytail
 - Practice bow
 - Practice socks
 - Monday & Tuesday: Sharks Practice Wear
 - Wednesday & Thursday: Team Practice Wear
 - Running shoes
 - Water bottle
 - Ankle weights
- Most teams will **run outside prior to practice**, so athletes must come prepared.

If an athlete is missing required items:

- They **may be required to sit out of practice**
- If bows or socks cannot be borrowed, a **new set will be automatically charged** to the account and used for that practice
- All athletes should have a **storage bin** in their assigned shelving area
- Athletes must bring a **water bottle to every practice**
- Water and sports drinks are available for purchase in the pro shop if needed
- Being on time is essential. When one athlete is late, it holds the whole team back. Athletes are allowed to arrive 15 minutes early to practice and may wait in the athlete area.
- 3 tardies are equivalent to 1 unexcused absence.

Camps and Extra Practices:

- School always comes first and we support our athletes' academic responsibilities 100%. Absences that are due to official school activities (game, performance, band, school trip, etc.) **will be excused as long as they are communicated in advance and we are able to verify them.**
- *Missing any of the following will incur an automatic \$50 fee, drafted from the payment method on file in your I-Class Pro account:*
- *Choreography*
- *Skills camp*
- *Upgrade camps*
- *Cleanup camps*
- *Any additional scheduled / added practices / extra practices*
These specific activities are not optional — they have direct impact on routine construction, stunt group placement, safety, and competitive readiness.
- *Our goal is not to penalize — it's to keep teams safe, prepared, and fair to the athletes who are consistently present.*

Thank you for working with us and for helping us maintain high expectations, consistency, and team accountability.

Attendance Before Competitions:

- Athletes may not miss practice or be late to practice during the **2 weeks** leading up to competition. If this happens, the athlete will be benched for the upcoming competition.
- Missing a practice within the 2 weeks leading up to comp **will incur an automatic \$50 charge, drafted from the payment method on file in your I-Class Pro account**, for coaches to re-choreograph the routine without your athlete.
- Even though they will not compete, athletes who miss practice in the two weeks before competition will still be required to attend the competition to cheer on the team.

Additional Charges:

- *Early Arrival/ Pickup Policy:* Athletes arriving 15 prior to practice, after the start time for practice, or being picked up more than 15 mins after practice **will incur an automatic \$25 charge drafted from the payment method on file in your I-Class Pro account.**
- *Being late to arrival time for comp* will result in a **\$50 charge which will be automatically drafted** from your payment method on file via your IclassPro account. It is VERY important that everyone arrives on time and ready!
- You are allowed *5 excused absences*. After this you are required to send in a doctor's excuse for any and all absences where your athlete is "sick" or "injured". If a doctor's note is not obtained your athlete should be at practice. Sick or injury related excuses with no doctor's note **will incur an automatic \$10 charge drafted from the payment method on file in your I-Class Pro account.**
- First unexcused absence \$10
- Second unexcused absence \$25

- Third unexcused absence \$250 & dismissal

Refunds:

- If your athlete is dismissed from the team due to attendance issues, no refunds will be provided for any fees.
- Participation in Florida Elite Sharks programs constitutes agreement to all policies outlined in this packet.
- All fees are final. No reimbursement or prorations will be provided for reasons such as illness, vacation, injury, or voluntary time off. Once you sign this document and commit to the season, you are obligated to pay all fees listed above (no exceptions).

Excusable Absences:

- The only excusable reasons for missing a practice are:
 - Illness
 - Death in the family
- Non-excusable reasons include birthday parties, family dinners, punishments, etc. We ask that you plan your family events and commitments around practice days.
- **Weekend Practices:**
- Coaches will schedule one extra practice each month on a weekend day. There is no additional charge for these required practices.
- *Missing these practices **will incur an automatic \$50 fee drafted from the payment method on file in your I-Class Pro account.***

Injury Protocol:

- Cheerleading can be a physically demanding sport, and while we have high safety standards, injuries can still occur. Please report any injuries your athlete experiences as sometimes athletes will not speak up on their own.
- If an injury prevents your athlete from attending practice, a doctor's note is **required** to sit out and to return to practice and must be emailed to floridaelitesharks@gmail.com prior to those practices being affected.
- No exceptions to this policy. We want to ensure that any injury is properly managed and that your athlete's health is prioritized.

Communication Policy

At Florida Elite Sharks, we value clear and respectful communication to ensure the success and positive atmosphere of our gym. As a parent, it is your responsibility to stay informed by regularly checking the communication platforms we have set up- this is mandatory for all parents!

Communication Platforms:

- **BAND:** This platform is dedicated to your specific team. All important team-related updates, schedules, and information will be posted here. Please check this regularly for the latest updates.
- **Athlete Band:** All junior and senior team athletes must participate in their specific teams band. They will submit cheer homework and communicate with their Coach via their team band.
- **Facebook:** Our **parent Facebook page** is for all things related to Florida Elite Sharks. It will have general information about the gym, events, and other Shark-related activities.

Both pages will always have the most up-to-date information. Please make it a habit to check these regularly to stay informed.

Expectations for Communication:

- These pages are intended solely for **informational purposes** and to maintain a **positive** and supportive environment. We ask that all interactions on these platforms remain respectful and encouraging.
- If any issues arise, please **do not address them on the pages**. Instead, contact **the gym owners or gym manager directly** to resolve any concerns. This ensures that we handle matters privately and professionally.
- **Negativity, complaining, or bullying will NOT be tolerated** on either the Facebook page or within the gym. Florida Elite Sharks adheres to **USASF Guidelines**, which strictly prohibit any form of bullying, whether **online or in person**.

Our Values:

- We are committed to maintaining a **positive, uplifting, and respectful environment** for all athletes and their families.
- If you believe someone is out of line, **do not approach them directly**. Instead, bring the issue to the attention of **Arielle or Hillary**, and we will handle it appropriately.

Zero Tolerance for Bullying and Gossiping:

- We have a strict policy against **bullying** and **gossiping**. This behavior is prohibited both in person and online. Let's all work together to create a supportive community where everyone can thrive!

Coaching Policy

At Florida Elite Sharks, we deeply value our coaches and the important role they play in the success and development of our athletes. Our coaches are highly trained professionals who are committed to creating a positive and safe environment for all of our athletes. We take great care in ensuring that our coaches are qualified, respected, and held to the highest standards.

Coach Qualifications:

- All of our coaches undergo a **background check**. We trust that our coaching staff is fully equipped to provide the best possible training and mentorship to your athlete.

Team Placement and Routine Decisions:

- All **team placements** and **routine decisions** are made by the coaches and finalized by the gym owners. These decisions are made with the best interest of the team in mind, and they are subject to change at any time based on the needs of the team or the progress of the athletes.

Expectations for Athletes:

- **Respect:** We expect all athletes to show the highest level of **respect** to all coaches and staff members. Disrespectful or disruptive behavior will not be tolerated.
- **Uncoachable Athletes:** If an athlete is being **disruptive** or **uncoachable**, they may be asked to **sit out** of practice or even be sent home for the day. We want to maintain a productive, respectful, and positive atmosphere for all athletes.

Expectations for Parents:

Our athletes have worked incredibly hard, and we want to create a positive and supportive environment for them. Please keep the following in mind:

Respect All Teams – Speak positively and refrain from negative comments about other teams, athletes, or gyms. Good sportsmanship is a key part of our gym's values.

No Direct Contact with Judges or Event Staff – If you have concerns, please bring them to our gym's coaching staff. Do not approach judges or event producers regarding our gym, scores, or competition results.

Represent Our Gym with Pride – Your behavior reflects not just on yourself but on our entire program. Be respectful, kind, and professional in all interactions. Let's create a positive and uplifting atmosphere for our athletes to shine.

Addressing Concerns:

- We welcome feedback and concerns, but we ask that you address them in an **appropriate and respectful manner**.
- **During practice is not the time** to discuss concerns or issues. If you have something you'd like to bring up, please reach out to **the gym director** at an appropriate time, and we will be happy to assist you.

Athlete Accountability and Demerit System

To ensure that every athlete remains respectful, responsible, and aligned with the core values of Florida Elite Sharks, we have implemented a **Demerit System**. This system is designed to hold all parties—athletes, coaches, and parents—accountable for their actions, while encouraging growth and improvement.

Demerit System Breakdown:

1. First Warning (Written Warning)

- **Description:** If an athlete exhibits behavior or performance that doesn't meet our team standards, a written warning will be issued.
- **Process:**
 - The gym director will document the concern in writing.
 - The athlete, coach, gym owners, and parents will all review and sign the written warning.
 - A copy of the warning will be given to the athlete, parent, and coach for future reference.
- **Purpose:** This step serves as an opportunity for correction and open communication about the expectations moving forward.

2. Second Warning (Written Warning + In-Person Meeting)

- **Description:** If the athlete's behavior or performance doesn't improve after the first warning, a second written warning will be issued.
- **Process:**
 - The second written warning will be issued, signed by the athlete, coach, and parent.
 - In addition to the written warning, a **mandatory in-person meeting** will be held with the coach, gym director, gym owners, parent, and athlete. During this meeting, everyone will have the opportunity to discuss the issue, address concerns, and develop an action plan to prevent further issues.
- **Purpose:** This step aims to provide additional support and a chance for the athlete to explain themselves while clarifying the consequences if the behavior continues.

3. Third Warning (Dismissal from the Team)

- **Description:** If the athlete's behavior or performance still does not improve after the second warning, the next consequence is **dismissal from the team**.
- **Process:**
 - The athlete will be officially removed from the team.
 - The athlete, parent, and coach will receive a formal notice explaining the reason for dismissal.
- **Purpose:** This step ensures that we maintain a disciplined, focused, and respectful environment for everyone. Dismissal is a last resort, emphasizing the importance of personal responsibility and accountability.

General Guidelines:

- The demerit system is meant to encourage positive behavior and personal development. It's not about punishment, but about growth, responsibility, and respect.
- Every step of the process is transparent and inclusive, meaning that the athlete, parent, and coach will all be involved in addressing concerns and finding solutions.
- The system is designed to give athletes the opportunity to improve, with increasing levels of involvement and intervention to ensure clear communication.

- **Contract Termination Fee.** Should a family choose to discontinue enrollment prior to the completion of the agreed-upon contract term, a \$150 Contract Termination Fee will be assessed.

We are committed to helping our athletes succeed, both in the sport and in life, and this system is in place to support them in their journey.

Additional Policies and Information

We want to ensure that our gym environment remains respectful, professional, and positive for both athletes and parents. Below are some important policies and expectations that help maintain this atmosphere:

1. Social Media Conduct:

All athletes, coaches, and parents must maintain a positive and respectful presence on social media. Bullying or gossiping about team members, coaches, or other gyms is strictly forbidden and may result in dismissal from the team. We encourage all to be mindful of their online behavior and represent Florida Elite Sharks with pride and respect.

2. Practice Schedule Adjustments:

Please be aware that practices may be added or subtracted throughout the season. We will communicate any changes well in advance, but it's important to stay flexible and be prepared for any schedule adjustments that may arise.

3. Gym Surveillance:

There are numerous cameras around the gym recording at all times for the safety and security of all athletes and staff. Please remember that anything you say to an athlete or parent should be something you would be comfortable saying directly to the owners.

4. Behavioral Expectations:

Foul language and inappropriate gestures are prohibited. We expect all athletes and parents to uphold a standard of respect and professionalism at all times while at the gym.

5. Parent Viewing Area:

Parents of athletes must remain in the parent viewing area or may watch through the bay door during practice. We ask that parents do not disturb athletes during practice times. We are one of a few gyms that have open practices and would like to keep it this way, so please do NOT enter the athlete area, interrupt practices, or distract athletes during this time. The parent viewing area is intended to be a positive and supportive space for both athletes and their families.

6. Florida Elite Sharks Logo:

The Florida Elite Sharks logo is the property of the gym and may not be used without explicit permission. If you'd like to use the logo for any purpose, please reach out to us for approval.

7. Spray Tans for Competitions:

Spray tans will be offered prior to every competition. We highly recommend that athletes get tanned, as the bright lights on stage can wash out their natural complexion. Tanning also helps create a uniform and polished look for the team, enhancing the overall performance.

8. Policy on Quitting or Removal from the Team:

If an athlete quits or is removed from the team for any reason during the season, they will not

be permitted to try out for the following season. This policy is in place to maintain commitment, consistency, and accountability throughout the year(s).

- 9. This is a drug free facility!** We are committed to providing a safe and healthy environment for all athletes. To support this goal, we enforce a strict zero-tolerance policy for drugs, including use, possession, and distribution. Any violations will result in dismissal from the gym. If your child is struggling, we offer resources and support to help. Please feel free to reach out with any questions. Thank you for your cooperation in keeping our community drug-free.
- 10. Additional Purchases:** We require every athlete to wear a hair piece. This gives our team a uniform look and maintains consistency throughout the gym for comp hair. All athletes must purchase the comp makeup that will be posted prior to comp season, we estimate this cost to be around \$45.
- 11. Tumbling:** All athletes will be required to attend a tumbling class twice a month outside of their scheduled practice times. These classes are offered on Mondays and Wednesdays from 5:30-6:30pm and occasional Fridays from 6-7pm.
- 12. Florida Elite Sharks reserves the right** to dismiss any athlete from the program at any time for reasonable cause, including but not limited to behavior issues, repeated policy violations, bullying, disrespect, attendance concerns, or actions that negatively impact the team environment. Our goal is to maintain a positive, safe, and respectful atmosphere for all athletes and families.
