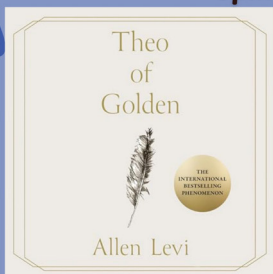
PAD THE PANTRY
