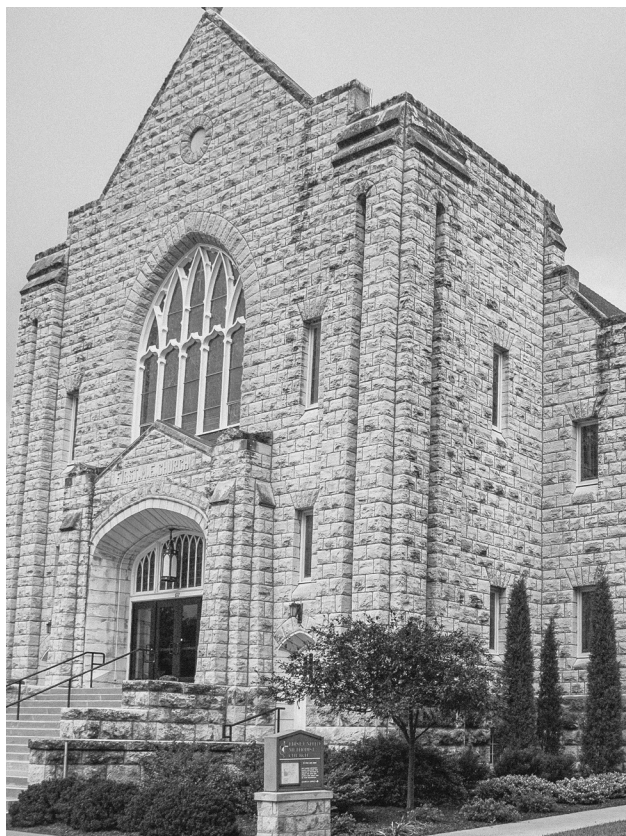

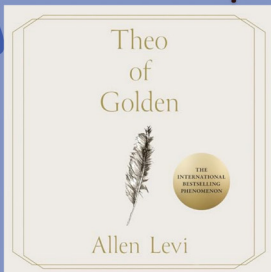
PAD THE PANTRY
