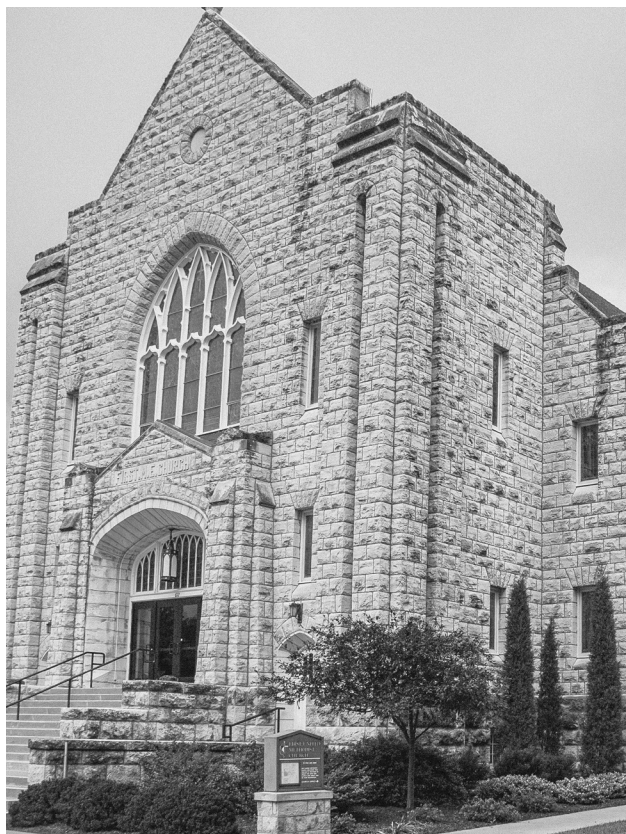

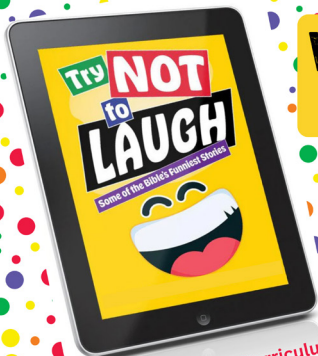

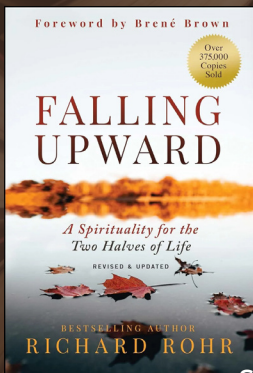

Join Pastor Mike this summer as he takes us through Richard Rohr's book "Falling Upward".

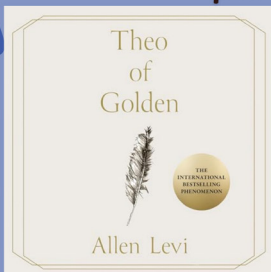
