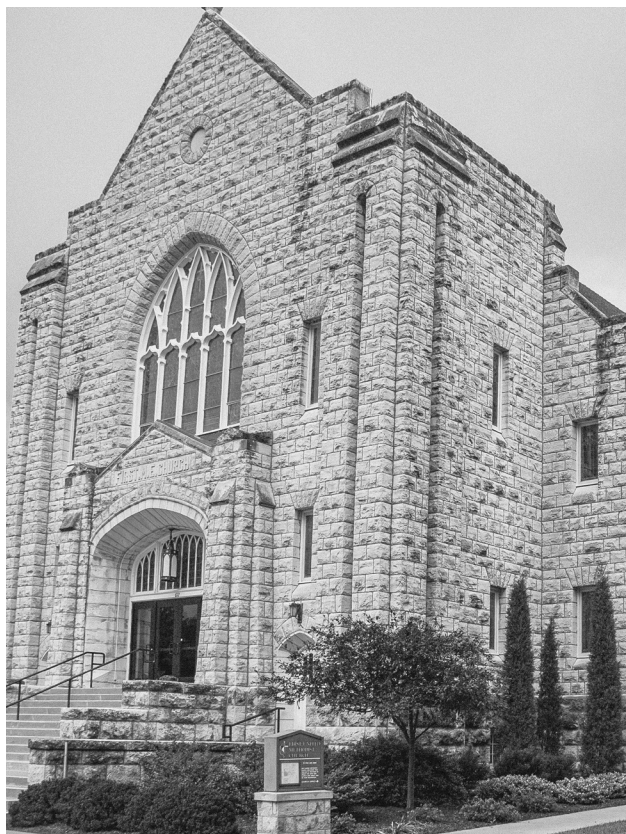

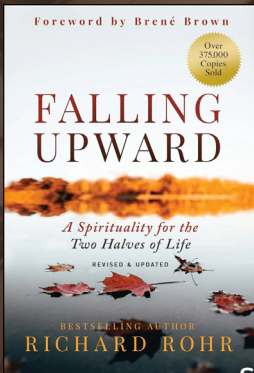

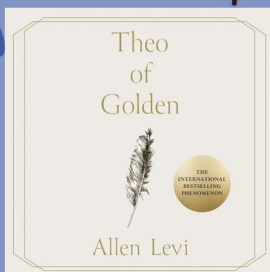
Book study WITH PASTOR MIKE
