25-Year-Old Justin Robinson Killed by Metropolitan Police

Washington, District of Columbia: On September 1, 2024, 25 year old Justin Robinson was killed by the Metropolitan Police Department. Mr. Robinson was found unresponsive in his car when officers arrived on scene. Mr. Robinson, slowly coming back to consciousness, was rolling down his window when one of the officers pointed his firearm inches away from Mr. Robinson's face. Mr. Robinson appears to try to remove the firearm from close range of his face when the officers fired several shots into the vehicle, killing Mr. Robinson. As he laid, bleeding out in the driver seat, the officer demanded Mr. Robinson put his hands up. At the time, Mr. Robinson was wearing his Cure the Streets jacket, a program oversaw by the District of Columbia Office of the Attorney General aimed at reducing gun violence.

A lawsuit has been filed in the United States District Court for the District of Columbia. The family is represented by powerhouse attorneys Andrew O. Clarke, Esquire, Jade E. Mathis, Esquire and Brandon Burrell, Esquire. The Complaint requests \$15,000,000.00 million dollars to compensate the family of the 25 year old who had his whole life ahead of him.

“Here, it is clear from the video Mr. Robinson was unresponsive and then startled by the commands of the police. Now, we plan to challenge the notion that sleeping in a car while black should be a death sentence in the District.” – Andrew O. Clarke, Attorney for the Robinson Family.
