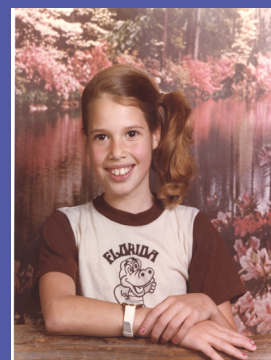
4th Annual Bonnie's Birthday Bash October 1 - 31, 2022

Stop Children's Cancer and the Division of Pediatric Hematology Oncology

2023 Update

The giving impact of Stop Children's Cancer over the past 42 years has allowed the University of Florida Division of Pediatric Hematology Oncology to grow into a top pediatric cancer center through the development of vibrant research programs. Multiple members of the UF Division of Pediatric Hematology Oncology are supported by Stop Children's Cancer, growing our division from five providers a decade ago to 12 providers today. Our research portfolios have also expanded — we now have over \$10 million in yearly grant funding to support our research team.

Clinical Trial Breakthroughs

The Stop Children's Cancer/Bonnie R. Freeman Clinical Trials and Innovative Therapies Program is a shining example of this generosity. For the past decade this program has provided over \$2 million to support pediatric cancer clinical trials, under the direction of Dr. Gigi Moore-Higgs. As a result, more than 1,000 children with cancer have enrolled in clinical trials: including several studying the use of new medicines and technologies, best treatment practices, and the biology of pediatric cancer.

These highly collaborative trials involve hundreds of pediatric cancer centers around the world and are among the best trials modern science has to offer. They have made major discoveries to improve the survival and quality of life of children with cancer. Stop Children's Cancer can take pride in supporting children from our community who participate in these trials.

Discoveries made through these clinical trials help children worldwide:

1. The addition of a monoclonal antibody to GD2 called dinutuximab was first tested by the Children's Oncology Group, and many of our children received this medication. In 2015, the FDA approved this medication for children with high-risk neuroblastoma based on the COG trial. This



medicine has improved the cure rate in high-risk neuroblastoma from 50% to over 70%. Since its discovery, approximately 6,400 children in the U.S. have received dinutuximab, and 1,300 children are alive and well who would have died without it. For the potential impact this discovery has worldwide, dinutuximab could possibly prevent the death of 52,000 children over this eight-year time frame.

2. In 2018, a clinical trial adding the T-cell targeted medication nelarabine to the treatment of patients with T-cell acute lymphoblastic leukemia improved outcomes by 10%. As a result, 5,000 children have been treated with nelarabine since this discovery, with approximately 500 children alive and well in the U.S. More than 20,000 patients worldwide could be impacted by this discovery.

3. In 2021, it was discovered that the replacement of traditional chemotherapy blocks with the bicistronic antibody blinatumomab improves the cure rate in recurrent B-cell acute lymphoblastic leukemia (ALL) by 20%. Since this discovery, over 1,000 children with ALL relapse have received blinatumomab, and 200 are alive and well in the U.S. Potentially 8,000 patients worldwide could benefit from this discovery.

In addition to benefitting from Stop Children's Cancer's generosity, our division has flourished because of their foresight to establish a research endowment. Case in point, Dr. Biljana Horn was recruited to UF with the help of the Stop Children's Cancer/Bonnie R. Freeman Professorship for Pediatric Oncology Research.

A Flourishing Research Enterprise

Since her recruitment in 2016, Dr. Horn has developed and led a national transplant consortium, bringing pediatric transplant centers together to determine better ways to deliver bone marrow transplants to children.

This consortium has published numerous research articles. They recently received a \$1 million grant from the State of Florida's *Live Like Bella* funding to test a method of removing cells in the bone marrow that cause graft versus host disease while keeping the cells that fight leukemia and lymphoma.

The professorship provides an attractive recruitment tool to entice talented researchers like Dr. Horn to UF. Now that Dr. Horn has retired, the Stop Children's Cancer/Bonnie R. Freeman Professorship for Pediatric Oncology Research is being presented to Dr. Elias Sayour.

Dr. Sayour is an internationally recognized expert in cancer vaccines and immunotherapy. He has developed a unique program called the Pediatric Cancer Immunotherapy Initiative (PCI squared) that focuses on using technologies to harness the power of the immune system to fight pediatric cancer.

In conjunction with this program, Dr. Sayour has developed clinical trials focused on RNA nanoparticle vaccines for glioblastomas, which are fatal brain tumors. Within PCI squared, Dr. Sayour is mentoring other younger physician-scientists to harness this technology for other types of cancer, including T-cell leukemia/lymphoma, osteosarcoma and Ewing sarcoma.

Stop Children's Cancer has also donated an additional \$50,000 annually to the Stop Children's Cancer / Kimberly H. Flaitz Research Grant Fund. This gift was a challenge grant to develop a clinical trial using technologies that we had created at UF Health to treat patients with osteosarcoma.

The proceeds supported the work of two young researchers in our division mentored by Dr. Sayour, Dr. Matthew Cascio and Dr. Brian Stover, who are working on different vaccine technologies to improve the outcomes for osteosarcoma.

This past year, we have recruited a world-class clinical trials specialist Dr. John Ligon from the National Cancer Institute who will lead the first of those clinical trials. We're right on time and on target in terms of opening this trial open at the five-year mark. Dr. Ligon will also be mentored by Dr. Sayour, and his research effort will be supported by the Stop Children's Cancer / Bonnie

R. Freeman Professorship. Stop Children's Cancer can take pride in this collaboration leading to a multicentered clinical trial!

Dr. Sayour also mentors Dr. Paul Castillo, whose research effort is also backed by Stop Children's Cancer. Dr. Castillo's research has benefited from donations to Stop Children's Cancer from the Lyrics for Life Foundation, founded by Ken Block, the lead singer for the classic rock band Sister Hazel.

Ken's brother, Jeffrey, died from T-cell lymphoma, which is a disease closely related to the T-cell leukemia that took the life of Bonnie Freeman.

Dr. Castillo is working on research to harness the immune system to find better cures for T-Cell leukemia and lymphoma. Already, Dr. Castillo has made exciting discoveries that promise to improve the outcomes for patients with leukemia and lymphoma, as well as solid tumors.

A Statewide Effort

If you consider the fact Stop Children's Cancer and Bonnie Freeman inspired the Stop Children's Cancer of Palm Beach County to become an 501c3 organization, then you know the impact is far-reaching in the State of Florida.

The Palm Beach group also funds a professorship that is supporting Dr. Joanne Lagmay who runs our Solid Tumor program, as well as Dr. Brian Stover who has worked on osteosarcoma vaccines and is interested in developing clinical trials for solid tumors. Dr. Lagmay also collaborates with Drs. Ligon and Sayour, and has developed a clinical trial focused on malignant peripheral nerve sheath tumors — a type of cancer that has no cure.

On a Personal Note

Finally, on a personal note, I've also received support from Stop Children's Cancer as a fellow in the 1990s, which supported a full year of research in the laboratory of Dr. Robert Christensen, an expert in fetal blood development. This opportunity led to my mentorship by two of the top leukemia

Stop Children's Cancer / Bonnie R. Freeman Professorship for Pediatric Oncology Research

This endowed chair was used to support the work of Dr. Biljana Horn, our Director of Pediatric Bone Marrow Transplantation. Dr. Horn has organized all the major Pediatric Bone Marrow Transplantation Centers in Florida into a consortium. Dr. Horn has led efforts of this group to successfully apply for a \$1 million grant from the *Live Like Bella Foundation* to use a new method of purifying bone marrow cells to preserve the cells that fight leukemia and lymphoma and rid

the marrow of the cells that cause graft versus host disease. The consortium continues to work together to understand problems related to transplant that are unique to the State of Florida. Dr. Horn has continued enrolling patients in an important national trial using chemotherapy, rather than radiation, to prepare patients for transplant. This trial may lead to improved long-term quality of life & reduced side effects and cancer in survivors.

Stop Children's Cancer / Kimberly H. Flaitz Research Grant

A key goal of this research fund was to support work on developing vaccines for pediatric osteosarcoma with the ultimate goal of opening a trial using one of these technologies in children. The funding continued to support the salary of Dr. Matthew Cascio working on developing lipid-nanoparticle(NP) vaccines and CAR T cell immunotherapy. In partnership with Drs. Cascio

and Milner (mentor), we have established a joint pediatric and large-animal cancer immunotherapy program. Together we have manufactured clinical grade lipid-nanoparticle vaccines. In pet-dogs with spontaneously-occurring OSA, we have shown that lipid-NP vaccines elicit immune responses with improving the dogs' long-term survival.

Stop Children's Cancer / Bonnie R. Freeman Clinical Trial Fund

This fund continues to support the program infrastructure, including the Director's position who has led our efforts in growing the pediatric cancer trials. Despite a year where we have continued to battle COVID, the pediatric oncology clinical trials continue to be one of the most productive in the cancer center. This includes enrolling 16 children on pediatric cancer treatment trials, 67 patients on basic science, supportive care or survivorship studies, and an additional 53 enrolled on the Children's Oncology Group registry

and biology study during the academic year.

In addition, our team actively recruited 4 subjects to Dr. Lagmay's investigator-initiated trial using Engineered Donor Grafts for Pediatric Stem Cell transplant in children with leukemia that will take place not only at UF, but also 5 other transplant centers in Florida. Funding has now been secured to open an investigator-initiated trial using a cancer vaccine to improve cures in patients with high risk and relapsed osteosarcoma.

Lyrics for Life / Stop Children's Cancer Jeffrey A. Block Research Award

This funding supported Dr. Paul Castillo, who is working on developing novel immunotherapies to treat refractory cancers, especially T-cell Leukemias and T-cell Lymphomas. Given the striking results of a combinational approach using CAR T cells and RNA nanoparticle-based vaccines, he continues his work using this approach that was reported in 2021. He has shown promising

data using this immunotherapeutic combinational approach for acute myeloid leukemia, metastatic osteosarcoma and metastatic melanoma.

The promise of this approach is that it continues to hold anticancer efficacy for a wide range of cancers. This funding also supported a review paper that was published, describing tumor models for evaluation of CAR T cells.

experts in the world, Dr. William Carroll and Dr. Steve Hunger. Eventually, I had the opportunity to lead an international clinical trial focused on Philadelphia Chromosome positive acute lymphoblastic leukemia (Ph+ ALL), one of the highest risk forms of pediatric leukemia. We tested a new drug at the time called Imatinib, which was targeted against the protein that was made by the Philadelphia Chromosome. That particular drug improved the cure rate in Ph+ ALL from 20% to 70% in children. We have now reached a milestone where we're very close to being able to cure Ph+ ALL using cancer-targeted therapy and without the traditional forms of toxic chemotherapy that cause damage to the body, and even lead to death in some of our patients.

In conclusion, the success of our growing, nationally recognized pediatric cancer program can be —to a great extent —attributed to the support from Stop Children's Cancer. Bonnie had a great vision, and we are so grateful to benefit from her vision and her legacy. Please know your support is making a huge impact in curing and improving the quality of life for children with cancer.

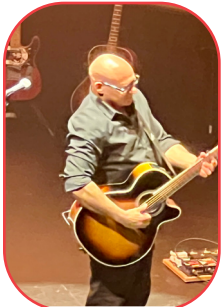

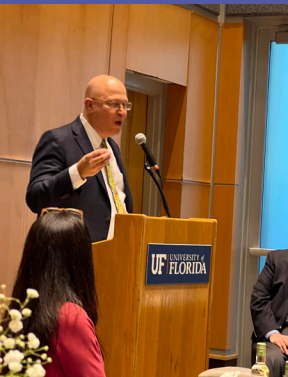
Dr. Gross believed UF faculty & students deserved the opportunity to engage in the most up-to-date research.

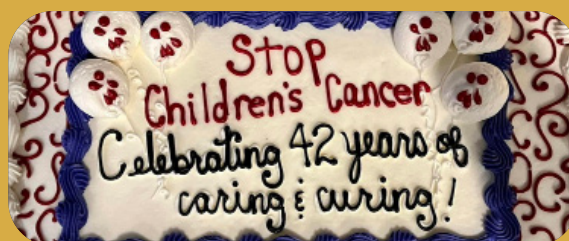
