Advocate for them while they are away.



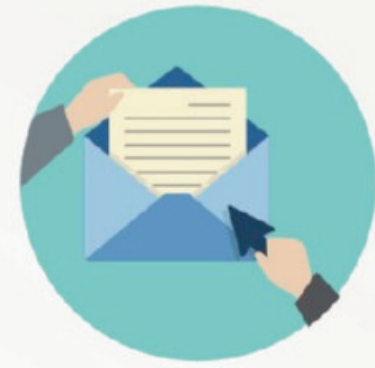
Surprise them with a phone call (at the proper time of day).



Repost their important announcements to your social media.



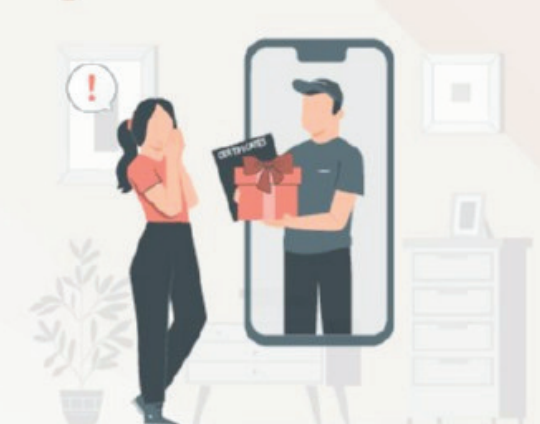
Send them a Care package.



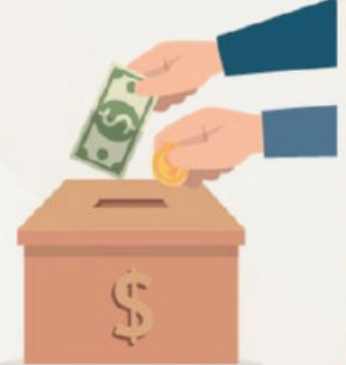
Recruit and screen new team members for them.

Put on a fund raiser to help them with a ministry project.



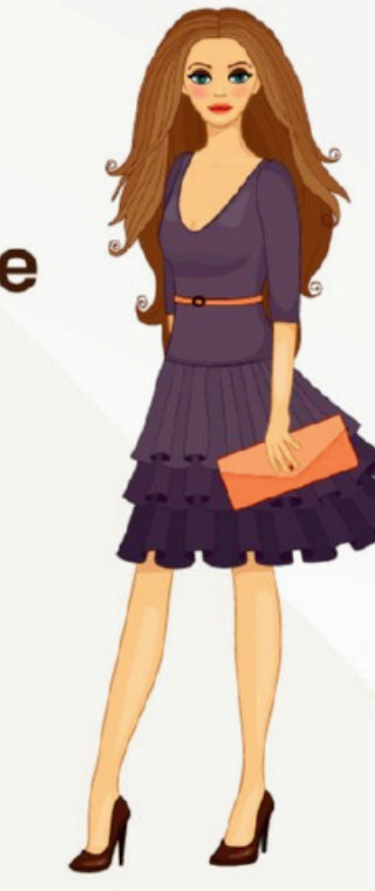
PRAY for them! And let them know when you do!

Invite them to hang out



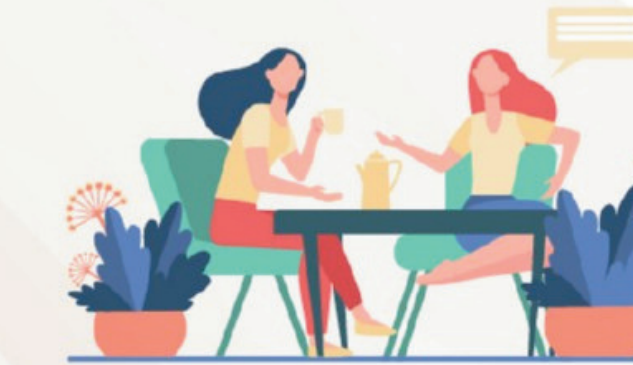
Take their kids for a night so they can go on a date

Do a Zoom interview with your class, congregation, or home group.



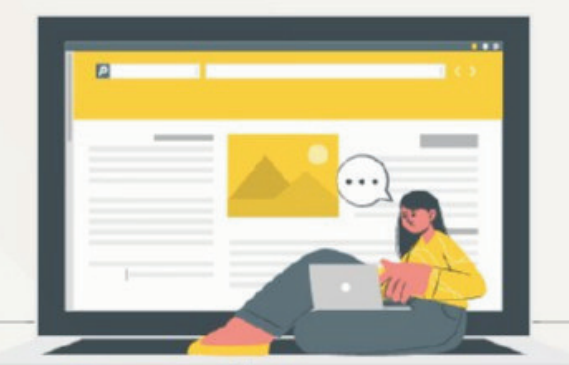
Send interesting things from their country of residence to use in sermon illustrations or missions events.

Give counsel on any church planting endeavors the church is doing, especially in the international community.



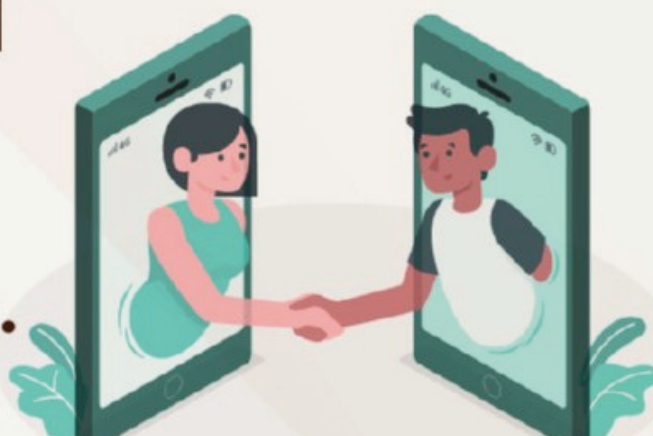
Pray for you and your needs.

Train people in effective gospel methodologies.



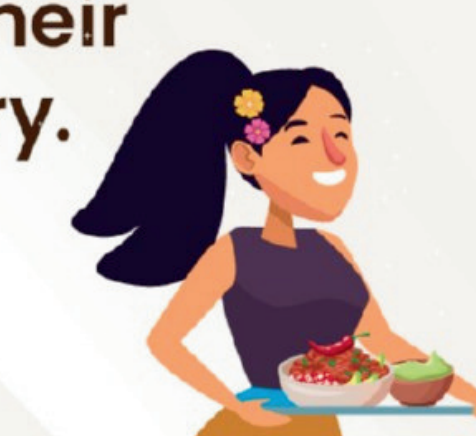
Help you develop a strategy for reaching the nations where you are.
