Ensure that all enrolment documentation is completed and signed, including the rules of enrolment, codes of conduct and debt management and contract cancellation policy.

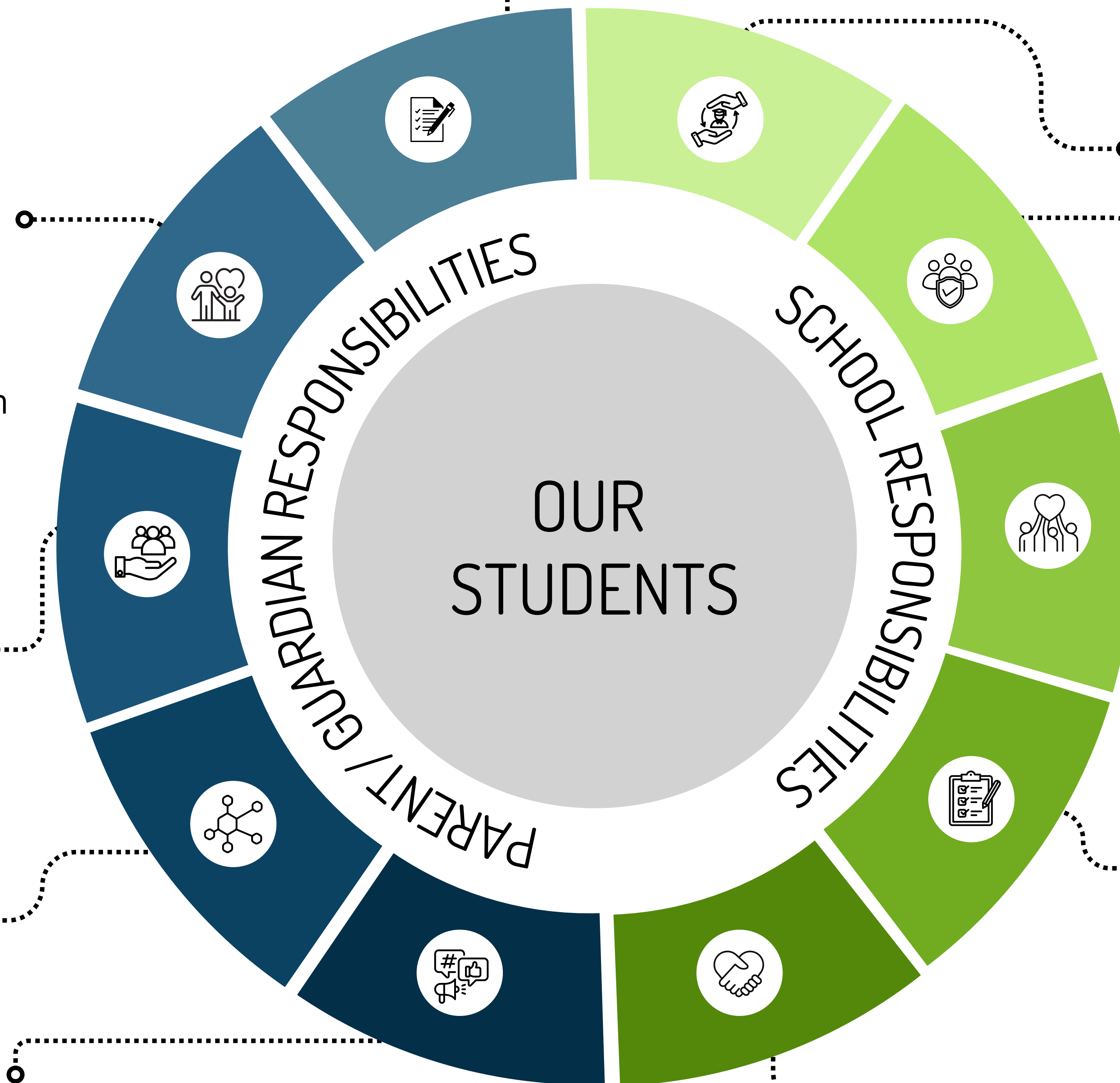
Support their children fully on their development journey, including

- Monitoring that assigned homework is completed
- Ensuring that they participate in extra-curricular activities
- Ensuring that they comply with the school's code of conduct

Support the school's management team and teachers to act in the best interests of the children.

Use the school's communication structure and escalation protocols to resolve issues before resorting to lawyers, the MD or Support Office.

Endeavour not to bring the school's name into disrepute, either on social media or by any other means.



Keep the best interests of children at the heart of all decisions and practices.

Make the safety of children in their care the top priority.

Ensure that all staff work together to create an environment that allows the school to meet its goals.

Ensure that teachers continually assess students' progress towards academic excellence and that assessment outcomes are shared with students and parents/guardians for ongoing improvement.

Ensure that teachers treat students, parents and guardians with respect. It is expected that this respect will be reciprocated.
