The Abbotts method is a comprehensive, highly structured approach to academic development, with supporting structured programmes to build life skills. For students who have not managed to achieve their desired marks, we give the opportunity to start over, consolidate the basics and renew their confidence.

We nurture our students to develop excellent study methods and sound examination techniques so that they can express their thoughts and knowledge more effectively. We offer a range of subjects in the FET phase and students are able to choose the subjects, within groupings, that best suit their abilities. SUBJECT IMPROVEMENT - GRADE 12

We believe in second chances; the aim of our part-time enrolments is to provide an opportunity to Grade 12 students who wish to upgrade their subjects based on the results they achieved in their matric results. This opportunity provides the students the opportunity to increase their marks which enables them to meet their tertiary Admission Point Score (APS) in order to be accepted to study in the field of their dreams.

Instead of saying "I did not meet the acceptance requirements" rather say: "I have not met the entrance requirements YET!"

Hundreds of students have joined Abbotts Colleges in the past 50 years to upgrade their matric results. Under certain conditions, we will allow students to take Mathematics if they had Mathematical Literacy previously. Please discuss this with us personally, as certain pre-requisites apply.

REQUIREMENTS TO UPGRADE

- You need to have written your matric within the last 3 years
- We accept students who have either the IEB Matric results or NSC Matric Results
- Students can re-register for up to six subjects (excluding Life Orientation)
- Students only come to school for the chosen subjects they are upgrading
- Students can register for a maximum of two new subjects if they wrote matric with the wrong subject combination


Compete on an equal playing field

Each prospective student attends a personal meeting with the campus Principal or Deputy Principal, together with their parents. During the meeting, the subjects which best suit the student's needs and aspirations are selected from our subject groupings and discussed with the principal. Academically, the only pre-requisite is that the student has passed the previous grade to the one he/she is applying for. For our international students, this process may be completed via a digital meeting.

APPLICATION PROCESS

Once the parent and student attend the personal meeting the application process can start

- 1. Please complete the Online Application on www.abbotts.co.za
- 2. Pay the R250 Application Fee via the secure Payment Gateway (PayU)
- 3. An Application Number will be forwarded to you
- 4. Upload all of the required documents (student birth certificate, parent/guardian identity document and latest academic report)
- 5. Once the school receives all the information, you will receive an Offer Letter that you will need to accept
- 6. You will receive an Admission Number to be used as reference when paying the enrolment fee (R2500). Please pay via the Secure Payment Gateway (PayU)
- 7. Lastly, we will issue you with a student number (SD Number) and confirm your login details to the Parent Portal on STASY (our Student and Tertiary Academic System)
