



MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING FOR ARTICULATION OF STUDENTS

SOUTHERN ARKANSAS UNIVERSITY

AND

SOUTHERN ARKANSAS UNIVERSITY TECH

This Memorandum of Understanding ("Agreement"), entered into by and between **SOUTHERN ARKANSAS UNIVERSITY** (hereinafter, "SAU"), located at 100 East University, Magnolia, Arkansas 71753 and **SOUTHERN ARKANSAS TECH** (hereinafter "SAU Tech"), located at 6415 Spellman Road, East Camden, AR 71701.

PURPOSE

The purpose of this Agreement is to facilitate the transfer and degree completion of students earning one of the specified Associate degrees at SAU Tech to the corresponding Bachelor degree at SAU. Through collaborative efforts, SAU and SAU Tech desire to provide clarity regarding the degree requirements herein, thereby affording students the opportunity to earn a high-quality degree from both institutions in the most efficient manner possible.

New Degree Program:

- I. AA in General Education to BSW Social Work

AGREEMENT

It is agreed that any student who has earned one of the specified Associate degrees at SAU Tech will be admitted to SAU with full junior classification, subject to the provisions listed below.

ADMISSION AND GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

- A. The student will have earned one of the specified Associate degrees at SAU Tech, with at least a 2.0 cumulative grade point average, on or after the Effective Date of this Agreement.
- B. The student must complete the requirements necessary for general admission to SAU.
- C. Degree program admission requirements for students who transfer pursuant to this Agreement will be determined in the same manner as if their initial enrollment had been at SAU.
 - a. For detailed admission requirements specific to each degree program, please refer to the SAU Undergraduate Catalog.

TRANSFER OF CREDITS

- A. Course requirements for each degree in this Agreement are displayed in the corresponding appendix.
- B. A transfer student who has not completed all of the courses specified within the corresponding Associate degree plan at SAU Tech, as stipulated on the above-referenced degree plan checklist, before entering SAU, must work with an academic advisor to ensure timely completion of degree program requirements.
- C. SAU will accept the transfer of credits, up to a maximum of 68 credit hours, for "D" grades subject to the following conditions:
 - a. The transfer of credits with "D" grades is available only to first-time entering transfer students at the time of admission to SAU.
