

# Band Festivals and Competitions

- We believe in taking the “art” of marching band to it’s “highest level”, giving the band members the “best education” and “musical experience” possible.
- We do not have an “**eye-on-the-prize**” philosophy, but rather stress the idea of doing the best job we can.....all the time!
- We believe in engaging the band members in a wide variety of performance-related venues including football halftime shows, non-adjudicated band festivals and adjudicated band festivals and/or competitions such as those offered through the OMEA (Ohio Music Educator’s Association), US Bands and/or the Mid-States circuit.
- ***Band should be meaningful, fun AND enjoyable!***

# Band Parents and Loading the Band Trailer..

- 1) Band Parents load things onto the band trailer whatever has been given to them by the band members.
- 2) Only band Parents and marching band staff are permitted in the band trailer when loading or unloading.
- 3) Band members are responsible for having everything they need in their instrument cases, and giving their cases to the band aids for loading.
- 4) When arriving back at school from a performance, every band member is responsible for waiting for their instrument to be unloaded and placing it back in it's appropriate spot in the music area.
- 5) While band aids may help in getting the percussion instruments back into the band room, it is the responsibility of the percussionists to put away their instruments and equipment once it has been unloaded!
- 6) In the event that you leave a football game, parade or other performance early, you **MUST** make arrangements to have your instrument cared for. **It's your responsibility!**

# Music Boosters:

# Attendance

- All after school and/or evening band practices, football games, festivals and/or competitions and parades are mandatory!

**NOTE:** In the event of an unavoidable schedule conflict the parents must email the directors in advance, not the day of an event. If a band member has committed to a marching band event but some other activity they take part in is rescheduled during the same time for some reason, they should attend the band event. It's only fair.

- We *do* work “on an individual basis” with students’ schedules if the student is part of a fall athletic activity or club. A job, babysitting, social functions, routine “well” doctor appointments, etc...are NOT excuses for missing practice and will affect the band member’s grade!
- Band students also participating in a fall sport **MUST** let the staff know when they have scrimmages or competitions. These schedules are due the 1st day of mini camp!
- Any band student who knows they have a schedule conflict must complete an Excused Absence Form and give it to one of the staff at least one week prior to their absence!

**#1** The first item the student will need is their band polo shirt for the June 20th U.S.A Days parade. Having your check in by April 7th will enable us to place all orders so things arrive on time!

**#2** **All payments are due by April 7th**. If payments are not received, purchases cannot be made from vendors for items such as shoes, t-shirts, gloves, lyres, etc...

## What is the “Annual” Marching Band Maintenance Fee?

This annual \$100 student charge covers many items including uniform cleaning, individual student supplies and equipment such as stands pep music, gloves, **UDB** and **flip folios**, and the cost of marching band drill design and **field paint!**

# Forms:

**EMF - Emergency Medical Form: (YELLOW) This form contains health information about your child including current ailments or conditions such as asthma, allergies, etc... as well as all medications that will need to be taken. This form must be completed and received before a student may participate at band camp. These forms are carried on the buses everywhere we go!**

- The EMF information is located on the school's **Final Forms** so there is no need for another “physical” (paper) form. **Fall season permission slips** will be due in the band office by the last day of school.
