All instructors are doing the required recertification for the season. Next hunter's education class will be the first Saturday in September.



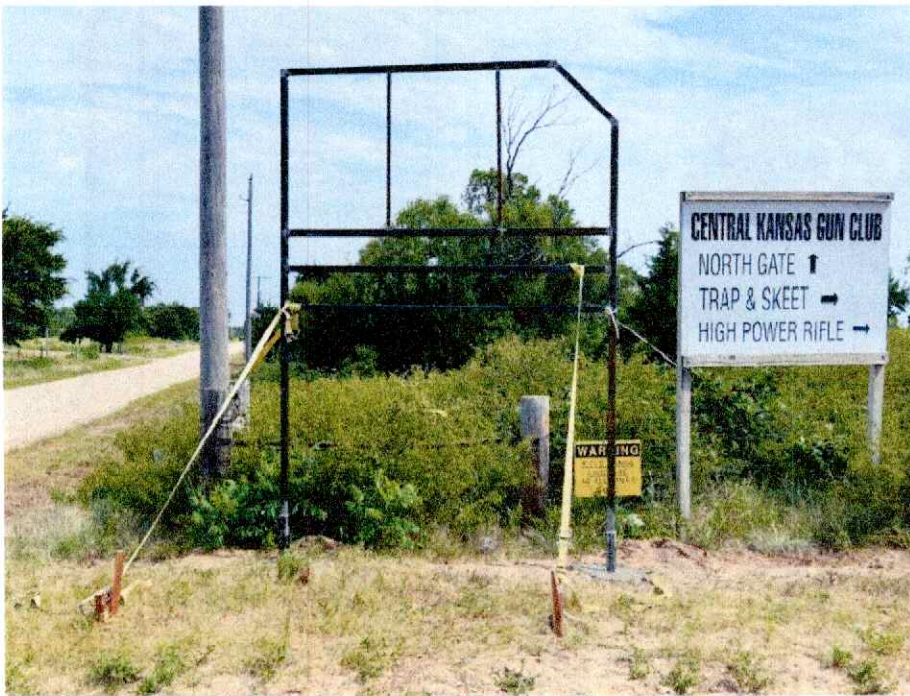

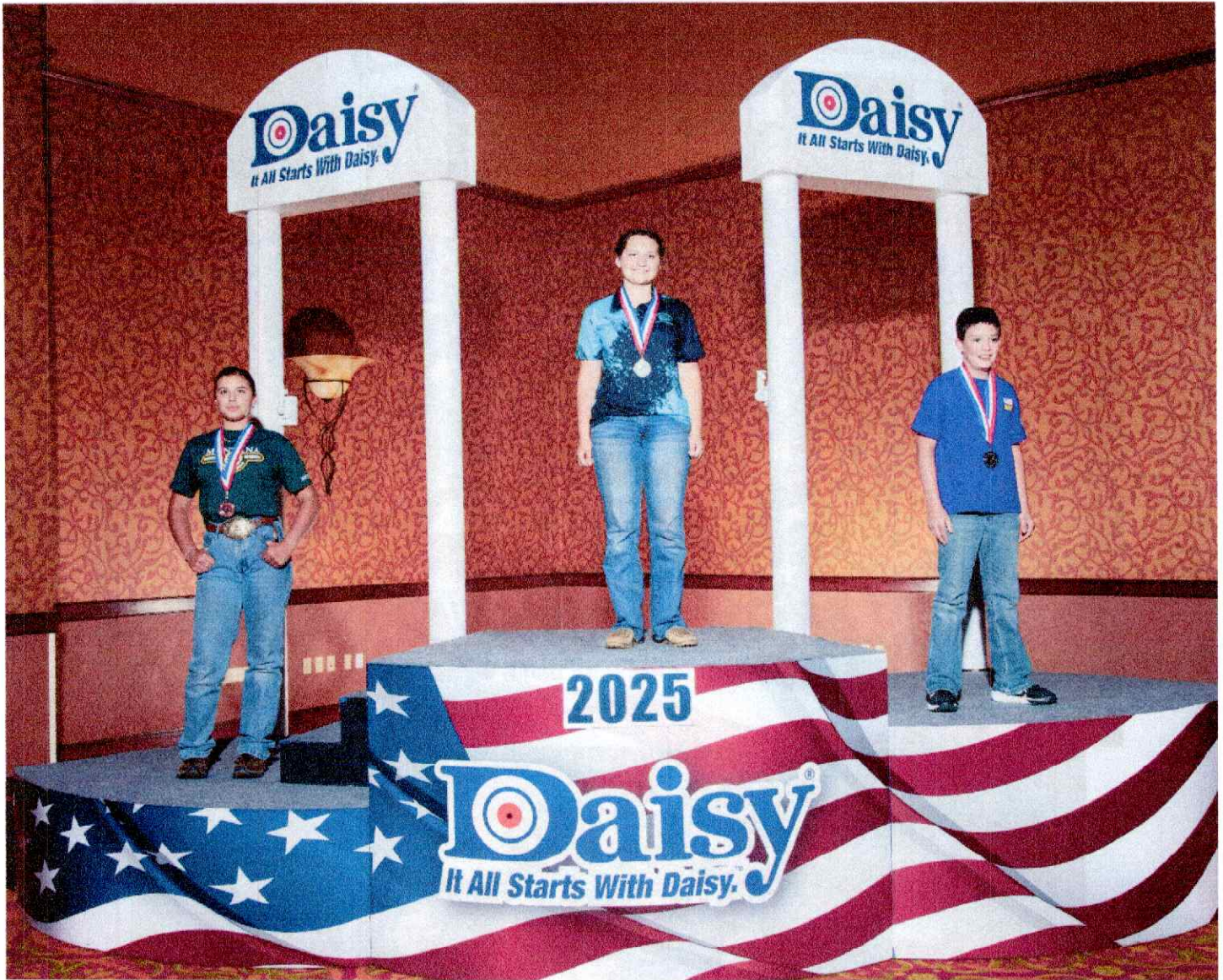

## 4H – PAGE

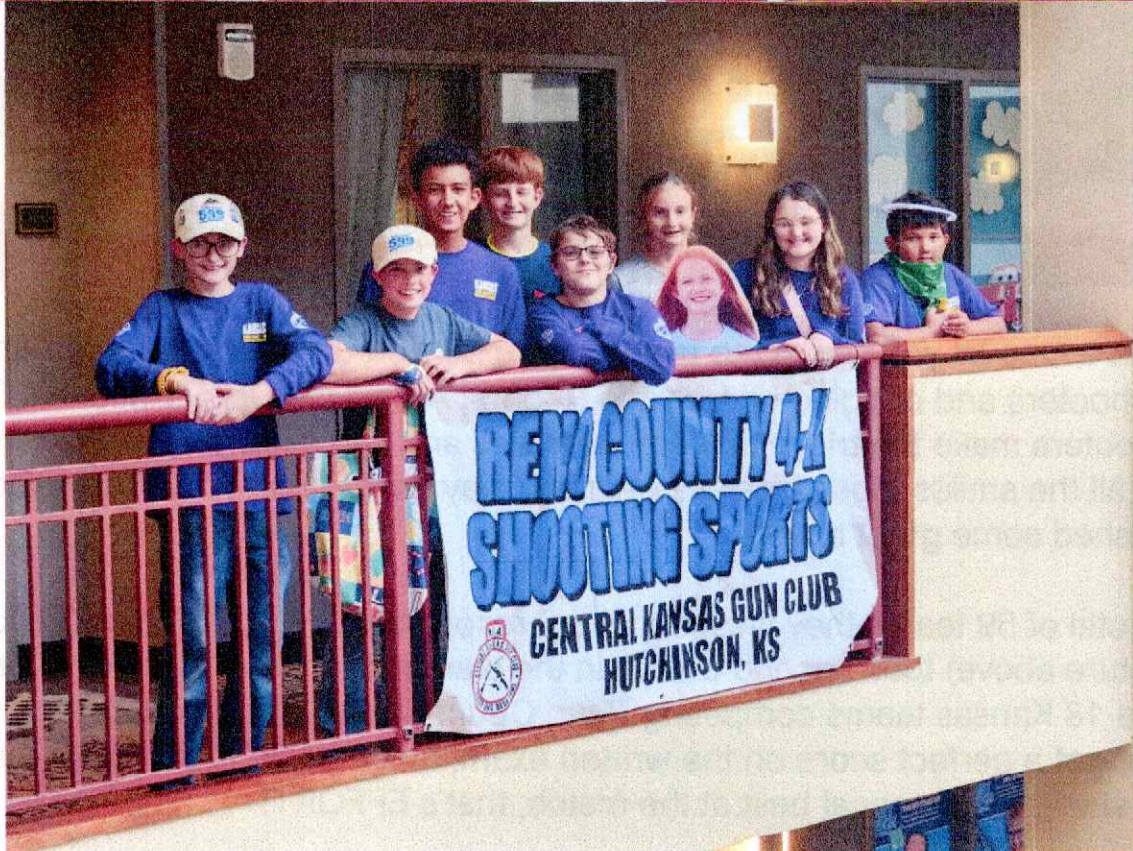
