Steel Challenge had 29 participants at the match on April 11th. USPSA had 19 participants.

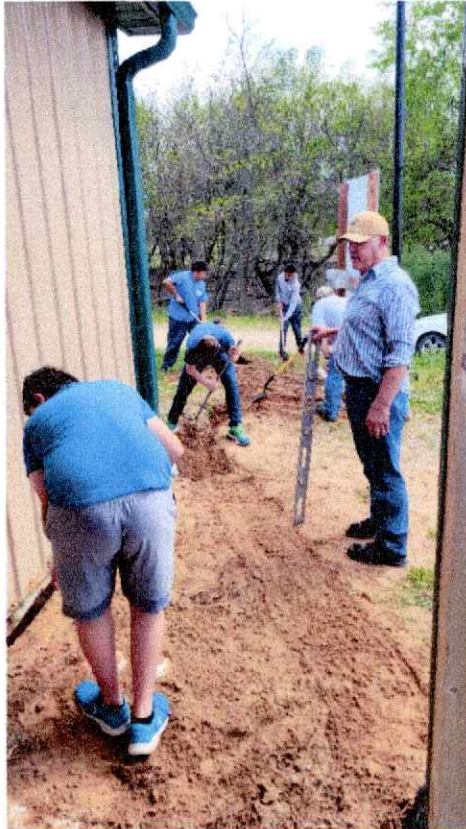
Hunter's Ed:
