Suggested Handling: Starting DOL 1-2, BX 2-3, DOR 3-4, BX 4-5, DOL 5-11 (layering #2/14 jump 10-11), BX 11-12, DOR 12-14 (layering #5/11 jump), BX 14-15, finishing DOL

Use this Challenge as a training opportunity!

If it is obvious that your dog is exhausted on the video posted of this challenge, even if the sequence is successful, you will NOT be entered into the Mid-Month Challenge Lottery
