The information I may collect:

You may give me information such as your name, address, and telephone number. By filling in forms on my site or by corresponding with me by phone or email.

With regards to each of your visits to my site, I may collect the following information:

- 1.Technical; information, including the Internet protocol (IP) address used to connect your computer to the Internet, browser type and version, time zone setting, browser plug in-types and versions, operating system, and platform.
- 2. Information about your visit, including the full Uniform Resource Locators (URL) click stream to, through and from my site (including date and time) services you viewed or searched for, page response times. Download errors. Length of visits to certain pages, page interaction information (such as scrolling, clicks and mouse-over), and methods used to browse away from the page.

Cookies
