

STANDARDISED PRICE LIST

All funeral directors are legally required to publish this Price List for a standardised set of products and services. This is to help you think through your options and make choices, and to let you compare prices between different funeral directors (because prices can vary).



<u>Attended funeral</u> – where friends and family attend a service for their loved one and attend the burial/cremation (our charges only).	£2295
Taking care of all necessary legal and administrative arrangements for the funeral service. This includes liaising with the Coroner, Minister, Cemetery, Crematorium, etc.	£1195
Collecting and transporting your loved one from their place of death into our care (within a 15 mile radius).	£200
Care of your loved one before the funeral in a private viewing room at our newly refurbished funeral home.	£100
At a date and time agreeable with you, transporting your loved one in our Mercedes hearse from their resting place to the agreed Church or place of worship, Cemetery or Crematorium.	£300
Viewing of your loved one for family and friends, by appointment with us (where viewing is requested by you).	£125
Providing a suitable coffin – made from veneered wood and finished to a high standard.	£375
<u>Unattended funeral</u> This is a funeral where family and friends may choose to have a ceremony, event or service for the deceased person, but they do not attend the burial or cremation itself.

<u>Fees you must pay</u>	
For an Attended or Unattended burial funeral, the burial fee. ¹ In this local area, the typical cost of the burial fee for local residents is: For a new grave, you will also need to pay for the plot; for an existing grave with a memorial in place, you may need to pay a removal/replacement fee. In addition, the cemetery may charge a number of other fees. ¹ This fee (which is sometimes called the interment fee) is the charge made for digging and closing a new grave, or for reopening and closing an existing grave.

² In England, Wales and Northern Ireland, you will usually need to pay doctors' fees as well. This is the charge for two doctors to sign the Medical Certificates for Cremation.
