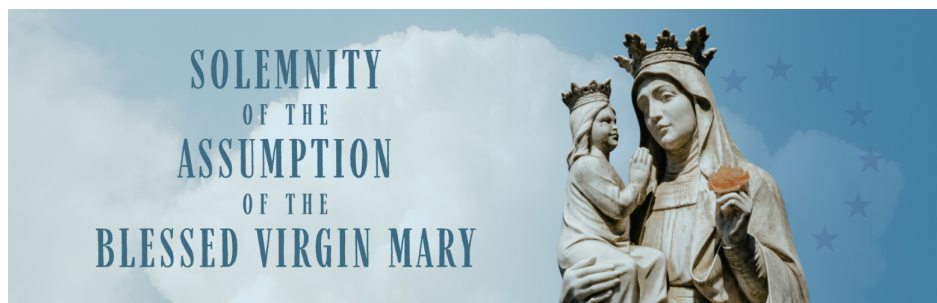
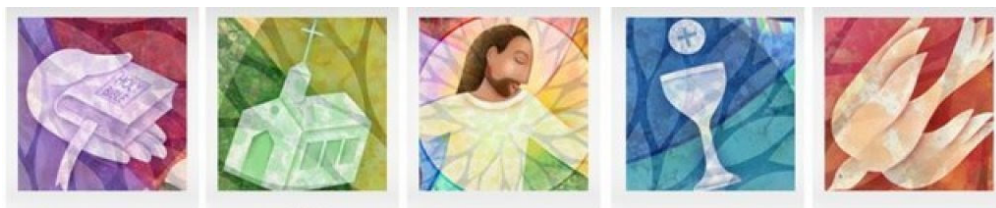




**The Feast of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary

The start of our new Faith Formation Year is just around the corner!

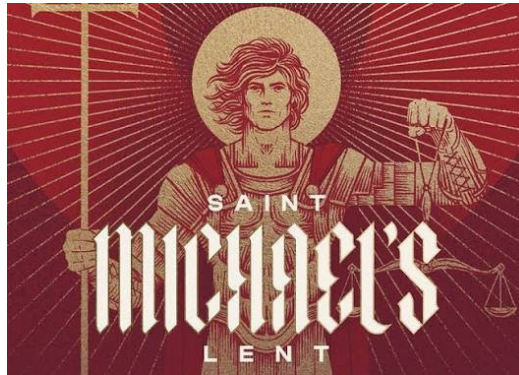
**We invite Parents and Children to our Faith Formation “Meet and Greet” on

St. Michael's Lent

August 12th - September 29th

Do you long for more in your life as a husband, father, and friend? **St. Michael's Lent** could be the beginning of a life more fulfilling than you could ever imagine.

Following St. Francis of Assisi, who withdrew to a mountaintop for prayer and fasting, we will pull back from distractions and focus on the things that matter most. During his life, St. Francis observed a 40-day Lenten period of prayer, asceticism, and fraternity in preparation for the Feast of St. Michael the Archangel on September 29th.

Over the forty days, we will unpack the Book of Daniel. Our theme for St. Michael's Lent this year is to "Stand Firm." Even as Daniel was thrown into the lion's den, and his friends entered the burning furnace, they remained unscathed because they put God first and refused to make any compromise in fidelity to him.

It's in the silence of prayer and with the necessary support of other men in the bonds of brotherhood, that we will find freedom in Christ.
