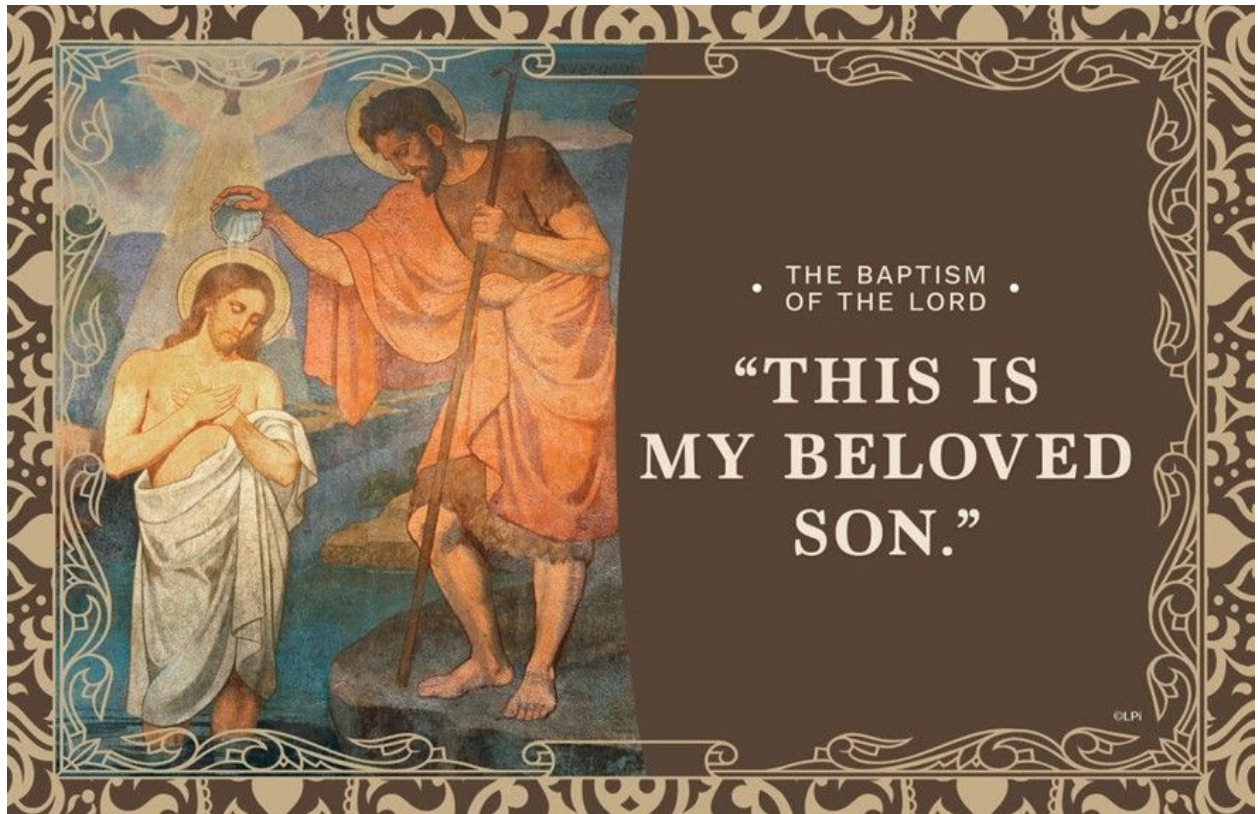




The Feast of the Baptism of our Lord
