



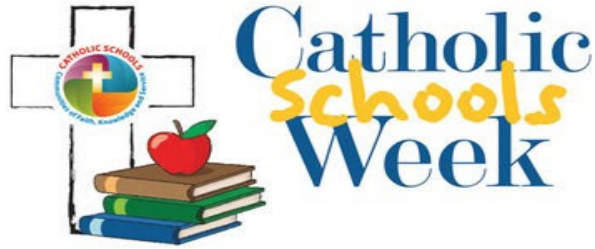
Join us for Game Night!!!
