Special Events

<u>Craft Beer & Wine Tasting January 27, 2024, in the SJE School Gym</u>

For 10+ years the SJE Educational Foundation has hosted the Craft Beer & Wine Tasting— a fun night with music, friends, unlimited tastings of 20+ wines and 10+ craft beers. The purpose of the Educational Foundation is to assist the school in its commitment to provide state-of-the-art technology and fund future capital improvements. It is the school's endowment.

Spring Fling: May 3, 2024, Halls of St. George/Schererville

Spring Fling is the school's premier event that attracts 450+ attendees from the parish, SJE School, and the local business community. The evening consists of mingling stations, beer and wine, live entertainment, dancing, silent auctions, and exciting raffles & games, with proceeds benefiting SJE School.

St. John Festival: July 11-14, 2024, at 93rd Ave. & US41

For over 100 years, the St. John Festival has brought the community together for food, family & fun. The event attracts upwards of 10,000 visitors that come to enjoy the free entertainment, food booths, carnival & games, gambling & beer tent, bingo, prizes, and more!

St. John 5K: August 10, 2024 at SJE School

The St. John 5K & 1-mile Family Fun Run/Walk supports the school and garners massive participation, attracting people from throughout the region—growing to over 350 participants last year, with higher goals to come! Proceeds benefit the school through the Educational foundation.

St. John Oktoberfest: September 20-22, 2024, at 93rd & US41

Oktoberfest celebrates the German heritage of the town of St. John and SJE by offering guests authentic German food, desserts, coffee, beer, wine, and music. A variety of children's activities are also provided so the whole family can enjoy the event. Over 5,000 people attend Oktoberfest each year.

Race for Education: October 18, 2024 at SJE School

Race for Education raises funds that enrich our students' academic experience. Over the years, the event has contributed to a variety of improvements, including Promethean boards, STEM resources, iPad learning centers, remodeled bathrooms, a new playground, and much more. All 390+ students participate, and there many advertising options for sponsors.

Trade Partnerships

A Trade Partnership is an **in-kind donation of goods and/or services** from a business that directly impacts the implementation of an event. It can result in valuable advertising exposure, as determined by the value of the contribution. As a general rule, the sponsorship level of a Trade Partnership is determined by taking the retail value of the in-kind donation and dividing it in half to align with the cash value of a sponsorship.

A Trade Partnership:

- Offers an opportunity to showcase your products/services to potential customers
- Results in valuable advertising for your business
- Increases the overall quality and success of the events
- Provides for the needs of the events at no cost, maximizing fundraising results
- Demonstrates your company's support of SJE

In-kind donation needs vary for each event. Some examples include:

Spring Fling: Floral centerpieces, wine, desserts, vacation raffle items, printing, postage, decorations, valet service, and audio/visual service. (Auction & prize donations are also welcome!)

St. John Festival: Bottled water (may be company-branded), wine, audio/visual service, event rental needs, paper goods, food supplies, kids' game prizes & features, printing, and advertising.

St. John 5K: Bottled water (may be company-branded), post-race food/drinks, prizes, and printing.

Oktoberfest: bottled water (may be company-branded), event rental needs, food, printing, advertising, and featured kids' activities.

Race for Education: Refillable water bottles or bottled water (may be company-branded), printing, postage, fun prizes for the kids, and gift cards (to use as incentives and prizes).
