Calamagrostis (Reed Grass)



'Avalanche'

Upright-held leaves of rich emerald with golden stripes.

Ht: 3-4' Sp: 15-18"



'Karl Foerster' Feather Reed

Erect emerald foliage with creamy white plumes in summer.

Ht: 3-4' Sp: 18-21"

Carex (Sedge Grass)



'Gold Strike'

Emerald blades with center stripes of

Festuca (Fescue Tuft Grass)



'Elijah Blue'

Frosty blue foliage, the best blue Fescue for humid conditions in the East, silvery flower plumes in late spring

Ht 8-10" Sp 10-12"

Hakonechloa (Hanoke Grass)



'All Gold'

Neon magenta/pink flowers, reblooms from May through September, frosted blue/green foliage.

Ht: 14-18" Sp: 18-24"



'Aureola'

Course blades of creamy yellow with streaks of deeper green, fall tones of red and purple.

Ht: 14-18" Sp: 18-24"

Miscanthus (Maiden Grass)



'Cosmopolitan'

Broad leaf form of rich green with creamy white variegation.

Ht: 6-7' Sp: 3-4'



'Gracillimus' Maiden

Standard Maiden grass, narrow silvery green blades.

Ht: 5-6" Sp: 3-4'

Miscanthus



'Morning Lights'

Narrow silvery green foliage with faint variegation short and stocky habit.

Ht: 3-4' Sp: 3-4'



'Porcupine'

Cross-stripe variegation over bright emerald blades.

Ht 5-6' Sp: 3-4'



Silver Variegated

Broad leaf of rich emerald with creamy white variegation.

Ht. 4-5' Sp: 3-4'

Muhlenbergia (Muhly Grass)



Pink Muhly

Thin blue blades topped with fuzzy plumes of bright magenta pink in late summer and autumn.

Ht: 2-3' Sp: 2-3'

Panicum



'Shenandoah'

Blue/green foliage with red tips, turning more red



'Cloud Nine'

Strong and erect blue foliage with white blooms in late summer.

Ht. 5-6' Sp. 2-3'



'Northwind'

Deep purple domes, striking color.

Ht. 4-5' Sp. 2-3'

Pennisetum (Fountain Grass)



'Burgundy Bunny'

Dwarf selection flowers all summer.

Ht: 15-18" Sp: 15-18"



'Hameln'

Semi dwarf form, amber plumes in summer

Ht: 12-14" Sp: 12-14"



'Karley Rose'

Reblooming plumes of smokey pink/rose, very showy, early

Ht. 2-3' sp: 18-24"



'Little Bunny'

Very Dwf. Form, thin green blades with miniature amber plumes in late summer.
