

# This term our Learning Journey is Rainforest Rescue



Where possible, our learning in each subject will have links to our learning journey.

## Geography

We will be learning what a biome is and explore the location and features of rainforests, focusing on the Amazon and comparing it to Redbridge. We will also learn how rainforests are changing, how people affect them, and why they are important to the world.



## Computing

We will be learning about data, designing questionnaires and using Microsoft Excel to enter, sort, and present information. We will also be programming by using micro:bits to create simple flashing and animated designs.

## Art

We will explore rainforest-inspired artwork using different painting techniques. We will study Georgia O'Keeffe and Marianne North and use oil pastels and chalk to create a still life artwork.

## MFL - French

We will learn how to use different greetings in French and how to say numbers.

## RE – in last 2 weeks of the term

## Science

We will identify flowering and non-flowering plants, learn about plant parts, water movement, pollination, and seed formation, and explore rainforest food chains and the impact of deforestation.

## Music

In music, we will be continuing to learn how to play the recorder. We will also be naming and playing samba instruments, copy simple rhythm patterns, and listen to and appreciate samba music from Brazil.

## DT

We are designing and making our own palm-oil-free product, including its packaging.

## RSHCE

Discussions will include: indigenous people, colonisation, and its impacts, as well as sustainability and how to seek help from trusted adults.

## PE

In outdoor games, we will be focusing on striking and fielding games.

In dance, we will be creating a dance inspired by the rainforest.

In Gymnastics, we will explore symmetry and asymmetry.
