

EURASIA? PRAYER GUIDE



Daily requests for July 2025 from our workers in Russia, Ukraine, Central Asia, and Georgia

TUE, JULY 1—

Pray that Leah S (Georgia) will have meaningful time with her young Ukrainian friend, D, who is coming to serve. D and her family have been displaced for three years and are struggling. Pray that God will bring healing during her time in Georgia.

WED, JULY 2 —

Pray that the Brubachers will get their boys settled in Ontario and have fruitful connections as they speak at churches and meet with individuals about their work in Eurasia.

THU, JULY 3 —

Pray that Renata H (Georgia) will have strength as she serves at a Youth for Christ camp and that kids will draw closer to God during the week.

FRI, JULY 4 —

10/10 Prayer Initiative: Ask the Lord to bring 10% of the world's Muslims to Jesus in the next 10 years.

SAT, JULY 5 —

Pray that the team traveling to Poland and Germany with Julie Mosse will minister effectively to Ukrainian refugees and at a camp. Pray that many kids will attend, for spiritual fruit, open hearts among parents, and that the team reflects Christ.

SUN, JULY 6 -

Rick Perhai (Ukraine) has an assistant (Sam) in the seminary MDiv program, who was stopped by the police and required to register for mobilization in the army. Pray that he will be spared from the draft and that the program continues receiving strong support.

MON, JULY 7 —

Pray that the Perhais, Burketts, and Wiebes experience refreshment, rest, renewal, and good connections with their families and supporters during their short U.S. summer home service.

TUE. JULY 8 —

Pray for wisdom and understanding for the new SEND workers as they go through the **Member Orientation Program** (MOP), July 6-17. Ask God to give them clarity, unity, and insight as they learn and prepare to serve.

WED. JULY 9 —

Join Meg Collier (Ukraine) in praising God that the church plant leader in Germany passed his German language test! Pray that Ukrainian refugees continue to adapt well to new cultures and challenges in unfamiliar environments.

THU, JULY 10 —

The war between Ukraine and Russia is ongoing. Pray that God brings peace to both nations and that His presence would protect lives and reduce the suffering of children and families caught in this conflict.

FRI, JULY 11 —

EL (CA) asks for prayer that solar panels, batteries, inverter, and accessories needed for their "Business As Mission" (BAM) arrive on time to the farm. Pray that reliable local subcontractors can be found to complete the roof.

SAT, JULY 12 —

Pray for **AF** (CA), who is still short \$100 in monthly support. Ask that her financial need is met soon so she can return to the field fully supported and continue the work God has for her.

SUN, JULY 13 —

Ask God to strengthen and encourage moms in Eurasia as they care for their families, support their husbands, and raise their children to walk with the

MON, JULY 14 —

Renata H (Georgia) will return to Canada for a six month home service. Pray for clear direction, renewed partner support, and refreshing time with family.

TUE. JULY 15 —

The Pray for Eurasia app is being regularly updated and will undergo another update soon. Pray for God's guidance for the team working on it and that the app blesses both those who pray and those being prayed for. Pray it bears lasting fruit.

WED, JULY 16 —

The CA team will host an English day camp, July 21-25, hoping to meet new people and invite them to follow-up events where they will hear about Jesus. Ask the Lord to touch the hearts of those attending and draw them toward discipleship.

THU, JULY 17 —

Pray that apartment sales in Russia and Ukraine go smoothly and successfully. Ask the Lord to bring the right buyers forward in His timing and provide peace throughout the process.

FRI, JULY 18 —

Pray for wisdom, provision, and unity during the International Council meetings, July 18-19. Ask that leaders clearly discern God's direction as they seek to advance His kingdom through SEND's global work.

SAT, JULY 19 —

Pray that MB (CA) will have a fruitful home service as she visits churches in Mindanao. Ask that those who hear her share will be encouraged by how God is working through their partnership.

SUN, JULY 20 -

MN (Russia) asks for prayer for summer activities at a café BAM. Pray that growing relationships lead to gospel conversations and

SEND's 80th anniversary celebration is July 21-22 in Michigan. Pray for rich fellowship, joy, and God's guidance as workers and leaders gather together.

TUE, JULY 22 —

Amelia Lin (appointee) will attend a mission conference in Taoyuan, Taiwan focused on introducing ministry organizations and calling people to missions. Pray for open doors to share about God's work in CA and for connections with Taiwanese believers passionate about missions.

WED, JULY 23 —

The Brubachers are at the International office retreat today. Pray for God's direction and for an encouraging, productive time with others.

THU. JULY 24 —

International student Bible studies in Georgia have paused for the summer. Students are taking exams before heading home. Pray that Rick K can disciple a few students individually while they remain.

FRI, JULY 25 —

Ask God to give wisdom and a shepherd's heart to our Team Leaders and Ministry Directors in Eurasia as they guide others and make impactful decisions.

SAT, JULY 26 —

Our Regional Director's sons, Nathan and Matthew, will attend a TCK transition seminar as they return to their passport country. Pray for discernment and peace as they navigate this change.

SUN, JULY 27 —

Pray for the **Lins** (appointees) as they continue preparing to serve in CA. Ask the Lord for strength, provision, and wisdom as they move forward.

MON, JULY 28 —

Pray that SEND Eurasia workers walk in the power of the Holy Spirit and experience the joy of following Christ in every area of life and ministry.

Daily requests for August 2025 from our workers in Russia, Ukraine, Central Asia, and Georgia

FRI, AUGUST 1 —

Pray today for 10% of the Muslims of the world to come to Christ in the next ten years. Over 180 mission and ministry outreaches have banded together to corporately cover every day of the year with prayer for Muslim peoples.

SAT, AUGUST 2 —

Pray for peace in Georgia as many are upset by stricter laws being passed. Ask God to calm hearts and give people wisdom in how to respond.

SUN, AUGUST 3 —

Chad Wiebe (Ukraine Ministry Director) is asking for prayer for strength for the Simply Mobilizing National Coordination Team as they finalize editing for the translation of Interface and leadership training materials for Kairos in Ukraine. Pray they finish these important missions training resources well.

MON, AUGUST 4 —

GP (CA) asks for prayer for her D-Group - that each girl would know God's unconditional love, grow in their understanding of His Word and in their personal relationship with Jesus.

TUE, AUGUST 5 —

Pray for Ukraine's church leaders as they deal with the loss of congregation members due to the war. Ask God to give them faith and strength to keep their eyes fixed on Jesus.

WED, AUGUST 6 —

Praise God for the many Ukrainians who have come to faith in Christ as they live through the upheaval of war. Pray that they will be deeply rooted in His great love, even in the midst of great sorrow.

THU, AUGUST 7 —

Pray for Renata H (Georgia) as she prepares to visit her home and supporting churches. Ask the Lord to provide the right person for her debrief.

FRI, AUGUST 8 —

Pray for Liza, a young Russian woman reading through Luke with MN (Russia) and another believer. Ask the Spirit to guide MN in helping this long-time seeker overcome her resistance and commit her life to Jesus.

SAT, AUGUST 9 —

Lighthouse of Hope Camp in western Russia, one of the country's first Christian youth camps, has been operating since 1997. This year's camp runs August 5-13. Pray for good weather, safety, and for the Holy Spirit to move in campers' hearts so many find salvation in Jesus.

SUN. AUGUST 10 —

Pray for MN (Russia) as preparations continue for a new church launch in Tambov. Ask for unity and humility throughout the process, and that the unreached in the northern part of the city will hear the gospel through the presence of believers in this developing area.

MON. AUGUST 11 —

Leah S (Georgia) will live in several places outside the capital this summer to practice language. Pray for growth in her skills and for gospel-sharing opportunities.

TUE, AUGUST 12 —

Pray for two Filipinos with a heart for missions in Georgia. Ask for God's clarity, provision, and orchestration as they prepare for a short-term trip.

WED, AUGUST 13 -

Pray for the Lins (appointees) as the Lord prepares them for their 2026 move from East Asia to Central Asia. Ask that their faith and dependence on Christ deepen and that God provides all they need.

THU, AUGUST 14 —

Pray for Alfie Mosse, Eurasia Director of Theological Education, as he engages with our workers and leaders of partner theological institutions.

FRI, AUGUST 15 —

EL (Central Asia) asks for prayer for safety for all involved in their BAM project. Pray that the Father's name is glorified and that they serve as faithful witnesses to everyone they encounter.

SAT, AUGUST 16 —

Pray for LG, Central Asia Ministry Director, as he provides leadership and oversight to all of our workers in KZ and KG.

SUN, AUGUST 17 —

AF asks for prayer for the registration of a learning and training service in Almaty. Pray that God provides people and opportunities for BAM trainings and expands their networks in and beyond Central Asia.

MON, AUGUST 18 —

Ask the Lord of the Harvest to call more workers to the needy fields of Eurasia and to move in the hearts of His people around the globe to participate in reaching these needy countries.

TUE, AUGUST 19 —

Pray for wisdom for our regional leadership as they serve partners amid regional turmoil. Ask God to help them care well for our members and lead with discernment and grace.

WED, AUGUST 20 —

Leanna Wiebe (Ukraine) asks for prayer for Revival Church and others holding outreach day camps for children and teens. Some come from villages without churches, and some have lost fathers in the war. Pray for open hearts and that many will turn to Jesus.

THU, AUGUST 21 —

Alcohol addiction is an epidemic in Eurasia. Pray that men and women in bondage to addiction are set free through the power of Jesus Christ.

FRI, AUGUST 22 —

Rick K (Georgia) has a son in Christ, Misha, who is visiting from Russia, Aug. 21-30. Pray for mutual encouragement and that Misha continues to grow in his relationship with Christ as Lord.

SAT, AUGUST 23 —

Ask God to strengthen friendships between our Eurasia workers and nationals in the countries where they serve. Pray for trust, mutual respect, and shared joy in the gospel.

SUN. AUGUST 24 —

From Aug. 25 to Sept. 15, a short-term team from GP's church in Manila will come to serve with her in Central Asia. Pray for God's guidance, wisdom, and provision - for the team to be a blessing and for lives to be deeply touched.

MON, AUGUST 25 —

Pray that our all-sufficient God protects His children from the evil one and keeps their minds fixed on Him-on His character, His promises, and His redeeming grace.

TUE, AUGUST 26 —

The Regional Council Meeting is today. Pray for unity, Spiritled wisdom, and a smooth, fruitful flow throughout the meeting.

WED, AUGUST 27 —

Pray for resilience and renewal for workers who have been displaced and stretched in many ways. Ask God for deep rest and true recovery from weariness.

THU. AUGUST 28 —

Rick K (Georgia) hopes to meet more often with Aleksei, a Russian young man living in Georgia for two years. Pray for strategic connections with Aleksei, and that he will recognize his need for Jesus and turn to Him for salvation.
