Dear Friend of SEND,

Twelve years ago, a SEND missionary family moved to Spain with a calling to plant churches where the Gospel had little presence.

In 2019, God led them to the Basque Country, to a region of 150,000 people with no evangelical church. They settled in one town and began the slow work of building relationships, sharing the Gospel, and discipling new believers.

There were days when no one came. At times, it was only their own family gathered to read Scripture and pray.

But God was at work.

Today, that small beginning has grown into a church of 35 believers, the first evangelical church in the Uribe Kosta region. This is what happens when the Gospel takes root where it has not yet gone.

And yet, **3.4 billion people around the world still have little or no access to that same opportunity.** No Bible. No church. No one to share the name of Jesus with them.
