



Chattanooga FC Academy - Disciplinary Policy

If a player, parent, or coach is in violation of any TSSA policy or any CFC Academy Codes of Conduct, or acts in any manner that discredits the Chattanooga FC Academy, that individual and incident should be reported to the executive director.

The following steps will be followed once an infraction is reported:

1. The executive director, coach and/or the team manager will solicit information about the incident, gather all pertinent facts and correspond with the affected parties.
2. Disciplinary Committee reviews the incident and has an internal discussion about the possible disciplinary action.
3. Schedule an appointment with the parent, coach or player who has been accused to hear his/her side of the story.
4. The disciplinary committee will have a final review of all the findings and make a disciplinary recommendation to the Board of Directors. Disciplinary action may include temporary suspension as a spectator/player up to expulsion from the club.
5. BOD votes on disciplinary action.
6. Disciplinary Committee will notify parent, coach, or player of disciplinary ruling.
