SUPPLEMENTAL LEVY ELECTION

JOINT SCHOOL DISTRICT NO. 201, FRANKLIN AND BANNOCK COUNTIES, STATE OF IDAHO

The Board of Trustees of Joint School District No. 201, Franklin and Bannock Counties, State of Idaho, is seeking authorization to levy a Supplemental Levy for the following purposes and approximate amount of levy funds to be allocated to each use:

Purpose: Salaries and benefits for specialized educators and counselors, including certified math specialists, special development and student interventions, English as a second language, and behavioral and mental health support. Amount \$280,000

<u>Purpose:</u> Increased wages for classified staff and substitute teachers. <u>Amount</u> \$450,000

Purpose: Maintain student extracurricular activities. Amount \$20,000

<u>Purpose:</u> Safety, technology, and security improvements. Amount \$250,000

TOTAL ANNUAL LEVY AMOUNT: \$1,000,000/year

QUESTION: Shall the Board of Trustees of Joint School District No. 201, Franklin and Bannock Counties, State of Idaho, be authorized and empowered to levy a Supplemental Levy in the amount of One Million Dollars (\$1,000,000) per year

for two (2) years, commencing with the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2024 and ending June 30, 2026, for the purposes stated above; all as provided in the Resolution adopted by the Board of Trustees on March 20, 2024?

The estimated average annual cost to the taxpayer on the proposed levy is a tax of \$82.44 per \$100,000 of taxable assessed value, per year, based on current conditions.
