It is and must continue to be the struggle of tenants to bring that system to the grave so that tenants and other people of the country can live with dignity and with security and equality in the housing market.

OPEN MEETING IN BOLHOLT 6

FINANCIAL SUSTAINABILITY & REGULATION

VOLUNTEERING & POOR FINANCE

Since the restoration and almost since the foundation of the union in 2013, it has been run on a voluntary basis.

In 2022, the organization received a grant of 5 million ISK from Vorstjarnan, which has been used to conduct opinion polls, obtain a legal opinion and to rent part of a office space.

The tenant union applied for an operating grant to the Minister of Social Affairs in the fall of the same year and received a part of the amount applied for. The grant was used to pay the chairman ISK 290,000 in salary (before taxes) part of the year 2023.

As can be understood, the scope of the work is enormous and it is urgently necessary to be able to pay people a decent wage for work that is sometimes on a par with what the trade union's offices produce.

The strategy is to make the Tenants union financially independent and sustainable, thus increasing visibility and strengthening lobbying.

WEAK REGULATION FOR TENANTS

The OECD has analyzed rent regulation within its member states. A questionaire was sent out, where the following elements were checked

- Regulations on contract prices
- Rules for the frequency and implementation of increases
- Rules on the duration of leases
- Housing security
- Powers to terminate a lease
- Short-term rental restriction rules

Based on the responses of the member states, a scale was created for the extent of regulations within them. The scale is from 0 to 1.0.

Iceland had the fourth lowest value, or only 0.14. The only countries below Iceland are UK, New Zealand and Israel. It is therefore clear that there is anarchy in the Icelandic rental market.

The tenantsunion has compared the increase in rent within the states with rent regulation and thus confirmed a very clear correlation between excessive increases in rent and weak regulation.
