Membership Is Worth It

The Holmen Business Association has been in existence since September 30, 1974. This organization has a long standing Purpose Statement which is to promote and protect the best interests of the residents of Holmen area; to promote and strive for the improvement and betterment of all public facilities and services within said area; to promote and encourage a better community and civic spirit and to foster good will and friendships between and among all residents of said area; to cooperate with county, town and village officials and with other civic and public organizations for the general welfare of the Holmen area.

We, as an organization, have worked very diligently through the years to adhere to this Purpose Statement. When the country was hit with COVID we had to take extreme measures to minimize contact and be within government guidelines for the safety of our members. We again are working very hard to reinvigorate this organization in this new era of COVID but have been faced with increased costs and expenses in this process. We have developed new ideas and worked to bring back prior activities that promote the ideals of our Purpose Statement.

So with our continued improvement and growth in mind we are increasing our annual membership fee to \$125 for Businesses and \$75 for Non-Profit Organizations. This will be able to be paid online through our new website. We are also adding the option to pay prorated rate of \$5 for each monthly meeting lunch up front also. The new rates will go into effect January 1, 2023.

This new payment option and more will be available on the new website that has a "go live date" of August 1st.

July Business of the Month Holmen Public Library

Holmen Public Library is one of La Crosse County Library's five service locations. Our unique model is built on collaboration with our municipalities providing the building, maintenance, furniture and fixtures and La Crosse County provides the Staffing and

resources. This successful partnership in the Village of Holmen dates back to 1978, when the library started in a room in Village Hall run by long-time Staff member Deen Layland who retired in 2019.

It was not long before the library had outgrown that humble space, and it was the Holmen Business Association that stepped forward and led the way to fundraise for the purchase and renovation of the former grocery store building on State Street where the library was able to serve the community from 1988 until 2017. In September of 2017, our brand-new facility with 18,000 square feet—including a Community Room and the County Library Administrative Center—opened its doors on 121 W Legion Street. We've been serving the Holmen community from this beautiful facility ever since and will celebrate our five-year anniversary this September.
