



Renewable Project Overviews



West Wyalong Solar farm

TradeConnex is proud to have played a vital role in the success of the West Wyalong Solar Farm, covering approximately 280 hectares in Wyalong, NSW, this 107 MWdc project stands as a shining example of sustainable energy innovation. With construction now complete, the solar farm operates at full capacity, generating an impressive 238,000 MWh of clean, renewable electricity annually.

Our contribution to this remarkable venture involved supplying skilled labour staff, ensuring the project's seamless execution. By partnering with PSD Energy on this transformative initiative, TradeConnex actively contributed to the generation of power for 39,600 homes, saving 190,400 metric tonnes of carbon emissions and effectively taking 63,400 fuel-burning cars off the roads each year. This collaboration underscores TradeConnex's commitment to facilitating the growth of sustainable energy solutions and marks a significant milestone in our journey toward a greener, more sustainable future.



Tailem Bend Solar farm - SFC

In the vanguard of renewable energy, TradeConnex proudly contributed skilled labour to the Tailem Bend 2 Hybrid Project. The Tailem Bend 2 Hybrid Project is the second stage of the Tailem Bend Project and is immediately co-located, with the Tailem Bend Solar 1 Project that is situated immediately south of Substation Road. The Hybrid Project incorporates a second solar farm, a battery energy storage system, and the construction of a new bay in the existing Coorong Substation.

The 128.5 MW project will comprise 87 MW of solar with 41.5 MW of battery energy storage, is set to power 35,000 homes annually while reducing 207,000 tonnes of CO2 emissions. Construction began in April 2022, marking a significant step towards clean energy in South Australia.



Rye Park Wind Farm

The Rye Park Wind Farm, strategically located north of Yass and east of Boorowa in New South Wales, represents a significant stride in sustainable energy within the Southern Tablelands and the South-West Slopes near Rye Park township. Spanning the local government areas of Hilltops, Upper Lachlan, and Yass Valley, this project unfolds across 11 km of predominantly stock farming land, emphasising a careful integration into the existing rural landscape.

TradeConnex, a key player in the success of the Rye Park Wind Farm, demonstrated its commitment to the project by sourcing skilled labour through its labour hire services. By supplying experienced and qualified staff, TradeConnex played a pivotal role in ensuring the smooth execution of the project, aligning with the broader goal of harnessing wind resources for clean and renewable energy in this picturesque region of New South Wales.

Civil Project Overviews



WestConnex Project

The WestConnex is a joint project between New South Wales and Australian Governments, designed to provide transport relief across Sydney.

Scheduled for completion in 2023, the WestConnex is a 33km motorway network stretching from the M4 at Parramatta in the West to Haberfield in the east. The M4-M5 Link — a critical component of the WestConnex tunnel — connects the Rozelle Interchange to the M8 at St Peters. In fact, the WestConnex project is the city's largest-ever transport project.

Operating on a massive scale, the WestConnex has involved a huge amount of contractors in taking it from concept to execution. And that's where TradeConnex comes in.

Here at TradeConnex, we've been fortunate enough to provide over 100 workers consisting of Skilled Tradesmen, Machine Operators & Labourers and support four different clients with constructing the WestConnex tunnel. We have also been fortunate to have worked on various project sections, including the M4 tunnel, M5, M8, and the M4-M5 Link.

This project required us to recruit across a number of different sectors. Sourcing the right team members for WestConnex jobs was essential, given the scope of the project and the number of different skill sets required. By working with the trade community across the city and beyond, we were able to deliver our portion of the project on time and to expectations, despite outside complications like COVID-19 and the resultant work restrictions

We're honoured to have played a part in its construction and been able to work on a project that reduces daily commuters' time travelling to work each day. When it opens in 2023, we'll be proud to have contributed to its creation.



Rozelle interchange

In Sydney's transport network, the Rozelle Interchange stands as a pivotal development, ushering in a new era of connectivity and efficiency. This cutting-edge underground motorway interchange is a key component of Sydney's infrastructure, designed to seamlessly integrate the M4-M5 Link Tunnels with the City West Link and provide an innovative underground bypass of Victoria Road between the Iron Cove Bridge and Anzac Bridge. Additionally, it lays the groundwork for the forthcoming Western Harbour Tunnel, marking a significant advancement in urban transport planning.

At TradeConnex, we are proud to have been instrumental in contributing to the Rozelle Interchange project, having mobilised a formidable team of over 75 workers consisting of Skilled Tradesmen, Machine Operators & Labourers. Our professionals, known for their expertise and dedication, have played a crucial role in the project's progression, showcasing our capability to meet the demands of large-scale, complex infrastructure initiatives.

Sydney Metro Project Overview

To date, we have provided over 100 workers, including skilled tradesmen, machine operators, labourers, and support staff, and we are currently still involved in recruiting for Sydney Metro jobs in the ongoing construction of this massive transport system. We work across various industries, project sectors, and sections of the completed Sydney Metro line routes and the ongoing Sydney Metro West project.

The city-wide Sydney Metro project required us to recruit on a large scale across different sectors, including expert machine operations, electricians, and general labourers. It was crucial to source the right team members with various skill sets to get the first phases of the Sydney Metro line routes and stations working in time. The accessible and contemporary rail network ensures full mobile coverage, upgraded concourses and platforms, and station wayfinding and signage system design improvements.

We are proud to have been a part of the Sydney Metro line and our ongoing contribution to the upcoming Sydney Metro West project, which will connect the upcoming Western Sydney International Airport and its surrounding regions.

The Woolworths Moorebank National Distribution Centre (MoNDC) initiative involves the creation of a new 66,600m2 semi-automated warehouse, complete with a fully automated terminal and precinct. This groundbreaking project is at the forefront of innovation, utilising state-of-the-art automation to construct customised pallets tailored for specific aisles in individual stores. The primary goal is to enhance on-shelf product availability by facilitating faster restocking, reducing congestion in stores, and fostering a safer work environment with decreased manual handling for the dedicated teams.

TradeConnex played a pivotal role in this transformative project, contributing 25 skilled workers encompassing forklift operators, general labourers, dogmen, riggers, and trade assistants. Their involvement underscores the critical workforce support needed to bring the cutting-edge technology to life, ensuring the successful implementation of a system that enables quicker, safer, and more efficient year-round deliveries to stores.2023, we'll be proud to have contributed to its creation.



Arnott's Distribution Centre

The introduction of the Arnott's Group's state-of-the-art automated distribution centre in Huntingwood, Western Sydney, marks a groundbreaking stride in the company's strategic vision for both domestic and international growth. Strategically located near the group's largest biscuit manufacturing site, this £65 million advanced distribution hub serves as the linchpin for over 60 percent of the group's national inventory, fostering substantial advancements in operational efficiency. Its advantageous location also positions it in close proximity to key distribution hubs for pivotal retail partners.

Spanning an impressive 43,000 square metres, the facility boasts an expanded capacity, now accommodating over 28,000 pallets—nearly quadrupling its previous capability. The incorporation of one-touch logistics, leveraging robotics automation, defines the facility's cutting-edge operational framework. This includes touch point automation and introduces a revolutionary palletising system featuring a towering 35-metre-high bay, underscoring the company's unwavering commitment to pioneering technology in logistics management.

Notably, TradeConnex played an integral role in this transformative project, supplying a skilled workforce that included solar panel installers, working-at-heights labourers, and general labourers. Their contribution was instrumental in bringing the innovative facility to fruition, showcasing TradeConnex's expertise and dedication to excellence on this remarkable site.


