

URBAN FIREARMS COURSE

Everyday Security Professionals carry their handguns in uniform or plain clothes and may encounter subjects that might use firearms or other weapons to attack and injure them or their clients.

Security officers cannot get ready, they must be ready, and to ensure that Officers are ready for situations involving the use of handguns and shotguns, the S.O.R. *Training Center* has developed this 16-hour program for Armed Security Officers, Private Investigators and Bail Enforcers. Because of calls for service might occur at any time attending Officers will also practice firearms training under low light shooting conditions to further enhance their firearm handling skills. All Courses of Fire will reinforce the following:

- Basic Shooting Stance
- > Two Hand Presentation Drills
- Clearing Malfunctions
- Speed and Tactical Reloading
- > Standing to Kneeling Drills
- Low-Light shooting conditions

SOR will furnish handouts and targets, however, each student must furnish their own handgun, outside-the-pants strong side worn at the waist/hip holster that attaches to a belt, (NO TACTICAL LEG HOLSTERS) magazine pouch, three magazines, 250 handgun rounds of factory ammunition – FULL METAL JACKET BRASS SHELL CASE ONLY, eye and ear protection, a baseball hat and handheld flashlight. For the 12- gauge pump-shotgun you will need - 50 Rounds of 12 gauge Birdshot, 10 rounds of 12 gauge OOB-9 pellet, and 20 rounds of 12 gauge Slugs (Always choose Low-recoil shotgun ammunition when available)

Each student <u>MUST</u> wear appropriate range attire and be prepared both mentally and physically to get into and out of a variety of shooting positions without assistance.
