#### The accommodation facilities

The immersive experience begins on the cobbled country road leading to the elegant entrance, framed by a wrought-iron gate, to Borgo Il Poeta. Guests are immediately greeted by majestic oak trees, the fragrance of a variety of herbs, rosemary, ceanothus and lavender, and by a sense of serenity, exclusivity, and wonder. Upon their arrival, Gabriele, the Borgo's "100% Umbrian" director, also known as "the Mayor" of the hamlet, welcomes the guests and hands them the keys to their Umbrian residence.

Borgo Il Poeta comprises a group of homes built in the sixteenth century around a watchtower that controlloed a large stretch of the border between Umbria and Tuscany. In 1707, with the construction of a small church dedicated to Santa Lucia, the small cluster of homes became Borgo il Poeta, the self-contained hamlet as we know it today.

The six residences built in exposed stone and arranged on different levels, express the sobriety and warm elegance typical of Umbrian architecture. Built and furnished by the skilled hands of local artisans over the centuries, the interiors of the homes are painted according to the palate of the Umbrian countryside: the green of the olive trees and the violet of lavender. Each room is fitted with a unique serena stone fireplace, waxed terracotta floors, Deruta ceramics, seventeenth century furniture, precious fabrics and comfortable wrought-iron beds. Casa Monte, Casa Loggia and Casa Torre can each accommodate up to six guests; Casa Santa Lucia and La Casetta a maximum of four; while the largest, Casa Tettoia, sleeps eight. Each house enjoys an enchanting view of green a fields and treelined hills overlooking the exuberant Tiber River valley. The estate includes an area equipped for barbecues under the stars, a tennis court and a swimming pool that is like shimmering terrace of water suspended over the rolling Umbrian hills and the enchanting shrine to the Madonna di Canoscio.

Local Winery owners offer Borgo il Poeta's guests a unique experience in their vineyards and private cellars, where the tastings speak of the art, culture and passion that comes from a long tradition of winemaking. Not to be missed, along the wine route between Perugia and Todi, is the Torgiano Wine Museum, defined by the New York Times as the best Italian museum completely dedicated to the culture of wine.
