Simple Truth Two: Sin entered and affected the world. Apart from God, we are lost in our sins and doomed to follow the desires of our flesh which leads to death.

For all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God. - Romans 3:23

For the wages of sin is death, but the free gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord.—Romans 6:23

Do you not know that if you present yourselves to anyone as obedient slaves, you are slaves of the one whom you obey, either of sin, which leads to death, or of obedience, which leads to righteousness? But thanks be to God, that you who were once slaves of sin have become obedient from the heart to the standard of teaching to which you were committed, and, having been set free from sin, have become slaves of righteousness.

- Romans 6:16-18

Romans 6:15-17 tells us that we are enslaved to something. Discuss how you've seen this truth in your own life.

Simple Truth Three: Jesus Christ came to deliver us from sin and death. He came not to condemn us or give us a list of rules and regulations, but to give us abundant life characterized by peace and freedom.

For God so loved the world, that He gave His only Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have eternal life.
—John 3:16

But to all who did receive Him, who believed in his name, he gave the right to become children of God.—John 1:12

The thief comes only to steal and kill and destroy. I came that they may have life and have it abundantly.—John 10:10

Jesus said to him, "I am the way, and the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me.—John 14:6

- In God's economy, the way to life is through death. Have you made the decision to believe that Jesus Christ's death on the cross was sufficient to save you from sin and give you eternal life?
- Discuss why people tend to think of Christianity as rules.
- Unpack what abundant life is all about.
