Romans 5:6-8 For while we were still weak, at the right time Christ died for the ungodly. For one will scarcely die for a righteous person – though perhaps for a good person one would even dare to die – but God shows his love for us in that while we were still sinners, Christ died for us.

**Romans 6:23** For the wages of sin is death, but the free gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord.

Romans 10:9-10 because, if you confess with your mouth that Jesus is Lord and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved. For with the heart one believes and is justified, and with the mouth one confesses and is saved.

- What are the consequences of salvation? What happens to us when we are saved?

## Review Romans 10:9-10.

**John 6:44** "No one can come to me unless the Father who sent me draws him. And I will raise him up on the last day."

- What ideas or images come to mind when you hear the word "father"? Why?
- How have you experienced God as your heavenly Father?

**John 14:6** Jesus said to him, "I am the way, the truth and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me."

• What is your response to the previous verse?

**Colossians 1:13-14** He has delivered us from the domain of darkness and transferred us to the kingdom of His beloved Son, in whom we have redemption, the forgiveness of sins.

- When have you experienced forgiveness from other people?
- What does it mean to have our sins forgiven by God?

John 16:13-14 "When the Spirit of truth comes, he will guide you into all truth, for he will not speak on his own authority, but whatever he hears he will speak, and he will declare to you the things that are to come. He will glorify me, for he will take what is mine and declare it to you."

• In what ways have you encountered or experienced the Holy Spirit?
