Silent Auction Raises Funds to Benefit Haiti

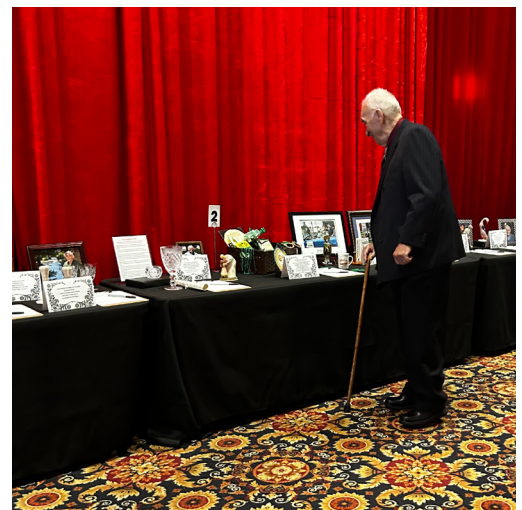
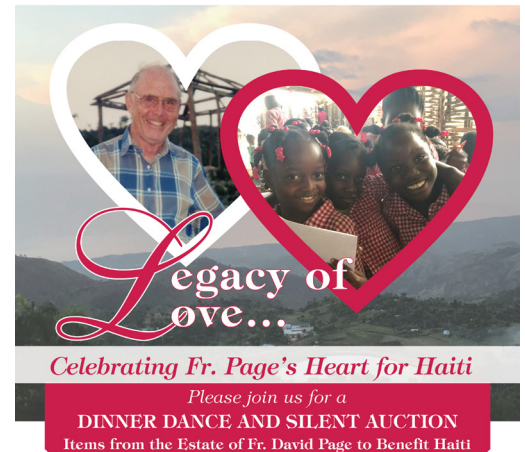
