Dear Brothers and Sisters,

I hope you are all enjoying the July 4 weekend. I am with you for Mass this weekend, but have written this column before I left for vacation last week.

In the midst of these weeks, we have felt a conflict in Iran that -- at one point -- seemed very far away from us, brought right into our country. I know many families and friends who worry about loved ones who serve in our Armed Forces, and we keep them in our prayers. War and conflict is never desired, and sometimes it is necessary.

Whatever the situation in our world or country, we must pray for our brave men and women who have to live this reality of war and struggle and uncertainty every day. We pray for our leaders and the leaders of other nations, so that they desire and work for peace.

This weekend, as we continue to celebrate our Independence, we thank God that we have people in our country willing to stand up for us, especially when we are not strong enough to do it on our own. A Great Point

I saw a post from a parishioner on social media recently that was awesome. He had mentioned that, while he was recently at Hersheypark with his family, they were all waiting in a very long and hot line for a ride. Some kids came up and butted in front of them and everyone else. And no one said anything. The parishioner said that he wanted to pick his battles, and thought it better not to say anything in case a fight would've ensued. He's probably right that it wasn't worth it, but it's always so hard to make judgment calls in those seconds.

But I loved that he posted this, and that he was worried about the lesson it taught his young children about doing wrong and getting away with it. It takes guts to write something like that publicly, as it was not just written to be a "look at me" sort of thing, but a learning lesson for parents everywhere.

It made me think, but also reminded me of how our Father in Heaven must feel. He has taught us right and wrong, but then puts us in opportunities where we have to live it out. We don't always feel punishment right away for bad choices or sin. Sometimes we don't "feel" the pain of our sin at all. Our Father must just witness our sin, as He gave us free will to live our lives, just as He has given us the help of Jesus, who teaches us all about the good life, and how to live it out.

And our Heavenly Father must also see what sin does to His other sons and daughters. Like the father in line at the ride, who worried about the effect of the misbehaving children on his own kids, so the Father must witness the destruction that comes on His unsuspecting children, who witness and feel the effects of sin.

Our Father in Heaven loves us, and sent His Son so that we might know how to live. He is so good that even when we do sin, we can come back to Him through the forgiveness He pours out in His Son. He is not a helpless Father, but one who gives everything. I pray for all of our parents, who constantly try to do the right thing for their children.
