A LETTER FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

It seems as though it's been Back to School week for many weeks already, as college students have been going back for awhile. But for most, this week and next is the time for our students to be returning to the classroom.

For those of our parishioners who are going away to school -- especially for the first time -- please know of our love for you. You are always part of our family, and we want you to know that we are here for you.

We look forward to seeing you when you get back from school later this fall for breaks, but please, PLEASE, find the Mass on your campus and go. You will meet people who have your values and Faith, and you will feel more connected to our God!

Even more, your Faith will become your own. I remember when I went to college for the first time, and I had to pull myself out of bed on Sundays to get to Mass. It was the first time that I felt responsible for living out my Faith. And I loved being with young people who believed the same Faith I tried to live.

For those students in grade school and high school going back: know of our prayers for you! Stay close to Jesus in prayer. He loves you and wants you to know that you are loved, even if it feels like others do not really appreciate you or love you. They will even seek to change you. Do not change because other people want you to change!

God made you differently for a reason. Stay close to Him, and you will know your value to Him: priceless. He gave His life for you! He loves you! Nothing anyone says about you matters, except what He says to you. And this is what he thinks about you:

"No one has greater love than this, to lay down one's life for one's friends" (John 15:13).

Have a great school year and study hard. But stay close to God, and you will flourish!

Our Parish Is Our Family

For a Catholic parish to exist, it needs love. Jesus provides that Love in the Eucharist through His Body and Blood for us. But we are asked to share His Love, given to us at Holy Communion, with others.

We must first share it with each other. And YOU have certainly done so!

I received this letter from someone who has temporarily lived in this area for a short time and attended Mass here occasionally, and wanted to thank us. He has just moved to another area. But he wrote, in part:

"I have fond memories of Seven Sorrows when I was in town. I have probably attended 20 or so churches/cathedrals...in various other spots on the east coast. No place has been more uplifting, inspiring, welcoming than Seven Sorrows."

Wow! What a beautiful note! That is YOU. That is how you made someone else feel. I hear this often.

Catholic parishes are not always known as the most welcoming. But it is important, because if someone feels welcome, they will engage and grow in their Faith!

So please, continue welcoming others. Push into the pew if you are asked. Help someone who looks confused. Welcome someone who looks new. SAY THE RESPONSES as we are directed. All of this makes others around you feel welcome, and they'll want to stay!

God bless you, and thank you for sharing the love of Jesus in the Eucharist with others, so that they'll want to come and receive Him, too! God bless you always, and have a great week.
