Dear Brothers and Sisters,

Next week, our parish will begin celebrating our annual 40 Hours of adoration of the Blessed Sacrament. This is a great time to give thanks to God for the gift of Jesus' Body and Blood in the Eucharist, and to sit with Him quietly in prayer.

Adoration will begin after our 10:30AM Mass on Sunday, and continue through Tuesday at 6PM. This includes overnight hours, which is an awesome time to go to adoration in the church. Everything is so quiet and peaceful at night, and to enter that time of prayer in our church is awesome. I hope you take part.

Every night at 6PM (Sunday Mass, and Monday and Tuesday services), Bishop Ronald Gainer, our retired bishop, will preach on the Eucharist. He is a great preacher, and very down-to-earth. I hope you come to hear his awesome words, and be drawn closer to Our Savior in the Sacraments.

On Tuesday night at 6PM we'll pray the Evening Prayer of the Church, Bishop Gainer will preach (as he will on Monday), and we'll have a small Eucharistic Procession. Bishop Timothy Senior will also join us that evening, which is a great gift! Please come and be with us to celebrate, with the bishops and priests and people, the Body of Christ as a Body of Christ! I really look forward to being with you!

New "Walk-up" Food Pantry

At the behest of a parish family and the Knights of Columbus, we have installed a small outdoor food pantry on our property for those in need. It is located near the Race Street entrance to our church and rectory.



Oftentimes, we have people who are desperate picking through the Knights' food donation bin in the back of church, and they're just looking for something to get through the day. It is not intended to be a "shopping for a week" type of thing, but just something to fulfill an immediate need. It has already been used extensively. We think this pantry will help in that. There have been similar setups in other Catholic churches in the area.

I am grateful to the work of the Schmidt and Wells families, who built the pantry, and to Tyson Fence, who dug the hole, poured the concrete, and set it. The Knights also helped, but will continue to supply the pantry.

In our parish, we have so many ministries which help those in need, including the homeless and the hungry. God bless you all for thinking of our brothers and sisters in need!
