I really look forward to this day, because it's so simple, but not irreverent. In fact, just the opposite. I think I experience the beauty of the Mass in a deeper way outside with all of you during this special day. Afterward, we'll have a free picnic lunch for everyone. Please come and bring chairs or a blanket for your family. If it rains, we'll have indoor plans, but let's count on great weather!

Last week, our Parish Ministry Fair and breakfast was a great success. Thank you to all who visited, especially to all the ministries who staffed tables. In particular, thank you to the Room at Our Table group, who provided the breakfast. You did such an outstanding job and took a lot of time to prepare that for us. Thank you so much for all you do for us.

Our Faith gives us the gift of Jesus' Body and Blood at Mass. We express that gift by our lives in the work we do outside of Mass. Our ministries allow us to do just that. Thank you for giving your time and treasure to our work!

The Monstrance Explained

Every weekday, the Eucharist is exposed for public prayer in our Adoration Chapel. The Eucharist is held in the monstrance, which -- in our parish -- is a large golden vessel. Some people have asked who the figurines are surrounding the Sacred Host.

Well, above the Eucharist, in the middle, is the Blessed Mother, with a crown, holding the baby Jesus. On either side of her are two angels. To the left of the Eucharist is St. Peter (recognized by holding the keys to the Kingdom that Jesus gave to him), and to the right is St. Paul (holding a sword, which is how he was martyred). On either side of each is an angel. The images on the monstrance symbolize some important things: Mary, holding Jesus, just like we hold Jesus in us when we receive the Eucharist; and Peter and Paul, the leaders in Rome of the early Catholic Church, which is the symbol of our unity!



I heard a good deal about a rock concert at Hersheypark last weekend that was very heavily attended, and apparently with some really popular groups. During the concert, there was a lot of music and merchandise that featured the devil. It was almost like it was glorifying him.

I strongly encourage you to not wear clothing, listen to music, or otherwise use Satan for entertainment purposes. He is not funny. He is not to be messed with. The culture has a strange fascination with the devil, and likes to put him in popular entertainment. It will then just say, "well, it's just for fun...he's not really real." Just because they say so doesn't mean it's the case. Jesus talks about Satan a lot in Sacred Scripture. He doesn't really make small talk or talk about things that don't exist. So believe Jesus when He warns us about Satan. In fact, He died so that we might be free of Satan and sin.

So, this Halloween, when considering costumes, avoid the devil and avoid things that deal with him. There are so many other great costumes to wear. When we invite the devil into our life, we are playing with fire. Let's embrace Christ and the awesome life He gives us, which destroys the power of the enemy!


Blessing of Religious Articles


