

A LETTER FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Brothers and Sisters.

October is Respect Life in the Catholic Church in the United States. As sons and daughters of God the Father, made in His image, we respect the gift of life in all areas.

This love and respect for life – because of our Faith and who we are – is built into us and must be lived out in us. That's because the world is enveloped in the darkness of the culture of death. We see that in the news every day. The only way that can be defeated – in all areas and stages of life – is that our witness to this awesome Truth is lived out in us.

While the term, "Respect Life," is beautiful, it puts the onus on us to determine the value of life and respect it. I prefer the term, "Sanctity of Life." Why? Because that puts the ownership of life where it belongs: to God, our Father. Life is holy, because He gives us His holiness!

He is the One who determines the value of life, not us. He has given us our dignity. It is not something we create on our own, or put a value on. Life is precious because it is precious to God. Life is protected and respected because God desires it to be.

As much as we create laws surrounding life issues, particularly on abortion, euthanasia, the death penalty, embryonic research, and many other areas, we desire to protect life not because it is a great political issue or because life is worth more to some people and not others. We create laws to protect life because God places a priceless value on life and desires it to be protected.

The Church, from the beginning, has always desired to protect the life of the unborn, the elderly, and all who are disadvantaged in any way. We strive to be pro-life in all areas, despite what our political parties tell us, because we are Catholic first. At the end of our lives, we will not answer to any human, but to God Himself.

Brothers and sisters, I write this as a man who struggles with being consistent. The world tells me that my Faith has no standing to inform me in what I am to believe on life issues. As long as we hold some pro-life positions (a few or at least a majority), then we are set. This is not true. From the beginning of life (the unborn) to the end and everything in between, we must desire to protect life, because this is God's desire.

I pray that we struggle with this as Catholics and Americans. I pray we desire to accept God's plan for life, so that we can be true heralds of life here on earth, and eternal life in Heaven. Thank you so much for your love for all life!

Outdoor Mass - Thank You!

What a beautiful witness of the Faith! Last week, over 500 of us gathered at Hoffer Park for our outdoor Mass and picnic, by far the most ever! Wow, I couldn't help but feel overwhelmed by the desire to be together and to enter into the Sacred Mysteries as One Body!

So many attended who had never attended a Mass before, or haven't in a long time. I know God will do awesome work through that event!

It takes a lot of work to put this Mass and lunch together. Thank you so much to Joe Trojcak and our choir; Art Bamert, who set up the sound system; and our awesome parish staff, who organized and set up everything, along with the Knights of Columbus, who are always helping whenever asked. They did a great job with all areas.
