A LETTER FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

You are so generous! Thank you to all who donate food to the Middletown Food Bank via our Knights of Columbus Collection box, or the many people who put food into our new mini-pantry on Race Street.

There are ALWAYS people at that pantry, whether they are putting food in (thank you!), or taking it out. There are so many people in need these days.

I wanted to share this note with you that I received regarding the pantry:

"Father, I was just at our church, dropping off a few items for the food box and a woman was there filling a bag. When she started to walk away, I got out of my car to put my items in, and I heard her praying, thanking God for the food she was taking, but also asking God to bless our priest, our nuns, and all of our church members. What an awesome moment to witness, as she was praying for us."

Wow, what an encouragement. You're making a difference! When we feed the hungry, we participate in the Corporal Works of Mercy, but it leads to Spiritual Works of Mercy. Feeding the Body and the Soul: this is the Catholic Church! Thank you for showing Jesus to our community in this way!

Don't Phone It In

A few weeks ago, I had the awesome opportunity to go to a Pittsburgh Steeler football game with my dad and brother. It was a Sunday night game, and it worked out that I could leave after the 10:30AM Mass. I really do not like missing a Sunday Mass here, but I thank Fr. Michael Grab for filling in for the 6PM Mass.

It was a great time, and the seats that a family friend gave to us were awesome. The Steelers lost (what's new!), but we had a fantastic time rooting for them and complaining about the play calling!

But I was kind of shocked to the extent that people were on their phones. We had the honor of attending the game in person – against the Packers, who are football royalty, like the Steelers – and considering the buzz surrounding the game, it was a highly sought-after ticket.

Yet most people were staring at their phones for most of the game. It didn't matter if it was one of those interminable television timeouts, halftime (with Poison's Bret Michaels "performing"), or one of the most exciting moments of the game. Most people were glued to their phones, and missed the moment.

I couldn't believe it! How could you be so fortunate to be in the stadium for the game, and you'd rather go on social media or text friends the whole time? It's crazy. You could stay at home and watch on TV, and save the money!

How often do I do this? I wasn't missing a key play, but I do check my phone, almost unconsciously, during conversations. What am I doing? How rude is that? How often do I walk and look at news or e-mails on my phone, all the while missing nature or someone to say "hi" to?

We are missing out on life, on reality, on surprises and joys, by being consumed by our phones. In the same way, what are we missing out on spiritually? I know that every free or quiet moment I have has to be filled with music, a podcast, or something. And I'm constantly tempted to look at my phone when I'm praying. What peace, what joy, what voice of God am I missing out on when I ignore Him for that phone? It's so selfish, and I'm robbing myself of His Life!

Life, as God desires us to see, is right in front of us. Let's not be so distracted that we miss it, and miss Him working in us!


