Matthew 25 Collection

Every year, the Diocese holds a special collection to help those in need in our area. The diocese collects the funds from all our parishes (last year, the collection was nearly \$400,000), and then it distributes grants up to \$12,000 to organizations all throughout the diocese that help people with housing, food and clothing.

Parishes keep a percentage of the money they raise to help the needy in their own parish. We have a constant stream of people who contact us with help paying rent, with groceries, or utilities. We use these funds and more to help our community.

The grants that the diocese awards do a lot of great work in underserved areas (the Coal regions and our urban areas). There are so many small "mom-and-pop" groups who do awesome work with very little overhead, and the Matthew 25's collection funds go a long way to keeping them in business and helping so many!

Thank you so much for your help with this collection, especially during this time when so many are in need. You make a very real difference. God bless you!




Children's Rosary
