A LETTER FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

We are growing closer to the great Feast of Christmas! And there are a ton of traditions we all have to mark these days.

Perhaps you go to Christmas Candylane at Hershey. Or maybe you go to the display at Stone Gables Estates in Elizabethtown. Or if you bake peanut butter cookies with the Hershey Kiss in them (I don't get a kickback from Hershey, I promise!). Or maybe you put up your decorations early (and watch the inflatables deflate every day!).

Whatever it may be, this time of year is so special.

But we truly cannot celebrate Christmas unless we have traditions that help us mark the birth of Our Savior. All of the lights, cookies, decorations, music – whatever – exists because of THAT BIRTH. And NOTHING ELSE.

And if God being given human flesh is the event we are celebrating, how do we prepare?

First, we have a tradition of blessing the baby Jesus' from your home nativity sets. Please bring them next Sunday so that we may bless them and see how beautiful they are!

Also – and more importantly -- as John the Baptist said in today's Gospel, "Repent, for the Kingdom of God is at hand" (John 3:2). We prepare by asking forgiveness of God first. And the way we do that is the Sacrament of Confession.

The hours for Confession are normal (see the front of the bulletin), but we will add our twice-yearly parish time of confession NEXT SUNDAY at 2PM. We will have a lot of priests to hear confessions, so please come and be prepared for the birth of Our Savior.

And as the Gospels of these last weeks have also told us, this is also a time to prepare for that day when we will meet Him again. We want to run to Him when we meet Him, and the only way to run to Him is to run to Him now and ask Him for forgiveness.

I know it is so hard, but please know that Jesus WANTS you to bring to Him your sins, even the ones you are most scared of talking about. He WANTS you to be free from them, so that you are no longer living in shame and darkness. That is what sin does to us. When we are free, we run to Him! Not away from Him!

Please take advantage of this time of confessions. If you can't make it Sunday, please come to our other scheduled times!

But Confession is not our only preparation. John later says in today's Gospel, we must show "good fruit as evidence of your repentance" (Matthew 3:8). In other words, once we are freed from sin, we must live as though we are members of Jesus' Body. We must serve others in love and in truth. Our Catholicism is not just lived out in the Confessional and at Mass, although it starts there. It is lived as we go home and to work and to the store as well.

God bless you, and as you prepare for Christmas, I pray you feel the warmth and love of Jesus. You will feel Him if you take advantage of the Sacraments He offers!


