## A LETTER FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

I pray your Advent is going well. Today (Sunday) is our parish time of confessions. Please consider attending and receiving Jesus' Love and Mercy and His healing power through this great Sacrament.

If it's been awhile since you've been to Confession, please don't worry! Many Catholics do not go to Confession often, or even rarely. Many of us feel as though it's another "option." I felt that way. It is not; it's actually essential to our life in Jesus!

Here are some questions you may have if it's been a long time since you've been to Confession.

### "It's been so long, I don't know what I'm supposed to do"

- Don't worry! We'll have a cheat sheet available that will have the order of Penance, and also the prayer we must pray (The Act of Contrition). Even if you are confused with this information, the priest will ALWAYS help you.

In addition, you do not need to put together a whole presentation. Just list your sins, and the frequency of times (if possible, specifically, but generically if not possible to be specific). A confession is not meant to be a long conversation. It must be short so that others may attend without having to wait a long time or getting told to leave because there wasn't enough time.

### "The priest will yell at me if it's been a long time, or if I say something bad."

- I can speak for myself, but I also know most every priest feels this way: We are blown away by your humility to attend Confession. Instead of judging you, we are grateful for your witness of Faith, and your example is powerful for us. Remember, we go to confession too, and want to feel Jesus' love and mercy, so we have the same worries you do, and we seek to aleve them!

### "I don't know what sins I am supposed to confess."

- We'll have an "Examination of Conscience" which will help you see what sins you may need to confess. Remember, we don't need to confess EVERY sin we've committed since our last confession. We MUST confess mortal sins (they are serious, we know they are serious, and we freely chose to do them). We CAN confess venial sins (less serious), especially those which we struggle with consistently.

I hope this helps! Please do not worry – it may be hard to get up the courage to go, but when you do go, you'll feel free, and you'll be so glad you went! Trust me, I know because I refused to go for 18 years before returning! And I'm so glad I did.

#### THANK YOU - LIVE NATIVITY

I cannot thank everyone involved with the Live Nativity enough for all they did to put on such a beautiful and prayerful event. We had over 700 people attend over the two hours, and many were moved to tears with the beauty of the night.

They may have thought they were moved by the nativity scene itself or the church or the star pretzels (!), but they were really moved by Jesus Christ! And I'm so grateful that all of our volunteers made themselves the face of Jesus to our visitors. Thank you!

Our Joseph and Mary this year were John and Jacqueline Punako. I asked them to write about why they chose to volunteer, and what they got out of the event:

"For both of us, it was an honor and a pleasure. It was truly meaningful for us to be able to participate in this together, and we found it to be a beautiful reminder of the Holy Family's love, faith, and simplicity. It also gave us the opportunity to slow down in this busy season and spend a moment focusing on the heart of the Christmas story. We were grateful for the opportunity to be a small part of something so special and to share in the spirit of the season with our parish community!"

John and Jacqueline helped others see Jesus, and through witnessing to their Faith, they found new friends and deepened their relationship with our parish and Jesus.

Thank you so much to Lisa Fortunato and Kate Warnagiris, who spearheaded this event, and the MANY parishioners who helped in any way.
