## A LETTER FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

Last weekend, we celebrated Gaudete Sunday, the weekend in which we get a glimpse of the joy of Christmas. It's been a long winter, and maybe a long Advent, and this Sunday is meant to give us a glimmer of joy that we'll feel on Christmas, so it keeps us patiently waiting for that great Feast!

As part of that, we asked you to bring the baby Jesus from your home nativity sets, so that they could be blessed. So many of you did! Pope John Paul the Second started this tradition, and he asked everyone to then take baby Jesus home and wrap Him and place Him under the tree, so that Jesus is the first gift you unwrap on Christmas morning.

How awesome is that? Perhaps even if you didn't have Him blessed last weekend, you can still do that with your family!

Part of the fun of this is that I get to see the many versions of Jesus that have been created. One of our parishioners has over 40 Nativity displays from all over the world! I look forward to seeing them. But one, in particular, stuck out. Steve and Karen Dubransky brought their Baby Jesus to be blessed. Thanks for letting me put this in the bulletin! I've never seen this before. Jesus is an adult in a baby's body!

After scaring me for a second, I really loved it. Why? Because everyone who tries to picture Jesus, has a different reason that He looks the way He does. In most cultures, Jesus has the features or the race of that culture. In others, He just doesn't look like we'd think He'd look like.

People will ask what Jesus really looked like when they see a representation that doesn't look real. The answer is, of course, that Jesus was a real person and took on the characteristics of his mother, Mary, as well as any characteristics of His Divine nature that God allowed be communicated through His Human nature. He had definitive characteristics that were real.

But it is awesome that everyone sees Jesus as a member of their own culture. Why? Because Jesus gives His life to us. We are created in His image. All of us are sons and daughters of God. We are another Jesus.

This Christmas, as we see different versions of baby Jesus, know that the greatest image of Jesus is YOU! Thanks be to God for such an awesome Savior!

As we know, our Christmas Masses will be crowded, and many celebrating here will be visitors and those who don't normally come to Mass. Please welcome you and are so glad you are here!

It is always hard to come into someone else's home, and feel, well, "at home." I've felt that before in many places, and even in Catholic churches where I've visited. It can feel very cold.

People tell me that, when they are visiting our parish, Seven Sorrows feels like home! Do you know how unusual that is for someone to say about a Catholic Church? That's a testament to your Faith and generosity.

I pray that we are welcoming to all who are worshipping Jesus at His Birth in our parish. It's such an awesome time, and everyone deserves to feel "at home" when being with Him in the Catholic Church.
