First of all, I'd like to thank Joe Trojcak and our choir, as well as the Cyran family, and all musicians, who provided our music to worship the Newborn King! Also, to all servers, lectors, ushers and Extraordinary ministers who helped to serve you and Him. Also, I'd like to thank our sacristans who prepare for Mass.

Finally, I'd like to thank our parish staff, including in the rectory office and our maintenance team, for helping to prepare for these magnificent days. Thank you so much for all of your work for all of us!

Actually, one more thank you: to all of you! Thank you for worshiping Our Lord with us, and for inviting your family and friends to Mass to experience His Love and goodness! What a great gift! You are a great gift to Fr. Josh and I. God bless you and THANK YOU!

A Blue Christmas?

Of course, we know that the holidays – or any day – is not always perfect or how we imagined it would be. There are always let downs and disappointments. Maybe Christmas wasn't all you hoped or prayed it would be. Maybe the letdown after the Feast Day was too much.

Jesus knew that we wouldn't always feel His presence, and we would need visible ways to know He was with us. That is why we were given the Sacraments! Especially His Body and Blood in Holy Communion – These are daily and weekly reminders of His Real Presence!

But miracles were also Jesus' way of showing us that He is still here. He needed them even when He walked the earth to prove that He was not of this world, but of Heaven. Miracles still exist. Remember Al Michaels' famous call in the 1980 Olympics, after the US beat the Soviet Union in hockey ("Do you believe in miracles?").

The sad truth is, many of us don't! Miracles, we think, are for fairy tales or for children. But not for serious adults.

At night, when I'm relaxing a bit but also trying to get some work done, I'll put on my favorite tv shows (game shows) and have them play in the background. But while watching one of the greatest game shows (Card Sharks!), this question came up...

"We asked 100 priests, do you believe that miracles still happen today? How many priests said they do?" What do you think the answer would be? I was hoping it'd be 100. But I was worried. The answer:



WHEW! I was so glad. 98/100! Do I wish it was 100? Yes, but in a world that doesn't think it's "the adult thing to do" to believe in miracles, that's great! YES, miracles still happen! How could a priest not believe so? At his command, by the command of Jesus, bread and wine become the Body and Blood of Jesus! A MIRACLE!

But every day, I see miracles. Healings, yes, but also personal triumphs, family divisions repaired, people coming back to the Faith,

employment found, joy returning to life. EVERY DAY is this witnessed. These are miracles, and also signs of Jesus' presence.

In these days, if you are feeling a bit blue, know that HE is with you, and these miracles that we all see, are signs to us of Jesus' continued presence in your life and mine! God bless you, and see you on New Years' Eve or Day for Masses for the Solemnity of Mary, Mother of God!
